## NORTH MERCER ISLAND/ENATAI Sewer Upgrade Project

August 18, 2022

### **Construction update: Expect intermittent loud noises and/or vibrations**

#### **Hammering to begin near Sweyolocken Boat launch**

As soon as August 24, crews will begin drilling the new sewer pipeline that runs under the Enatai hillside. An early step is to insert a steel case near the drilling entrance that will allow the rest of the work to begin. Crews will pound the steel case in with what is known as a pneumatic hammer.

While this work is happening you may notice additional noise and vibration.

#### **What to expect during pneumatic hammering:**

- Work will occur within permitted hours of 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Friday and 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturday.
- Intermittent loud noise and/or vibration during hammering
- Increased construction equipment and trucks hauling materials on roads near the boat launch.
