During the walk, the team will share the detailed route for the sewer upgrade and answer questions.

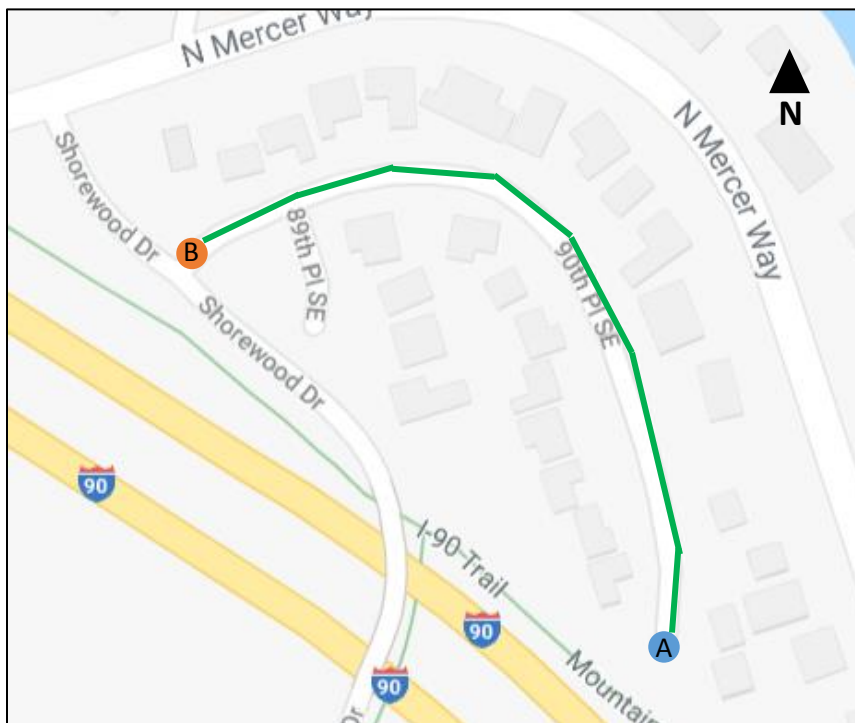
**We’ll walk rain or shine, so please dress for the weather and wear sturdy shoes for walking.**

We’ll walk ( — ) northwest on 90th Place S.E. for a total of 0.2 miles.

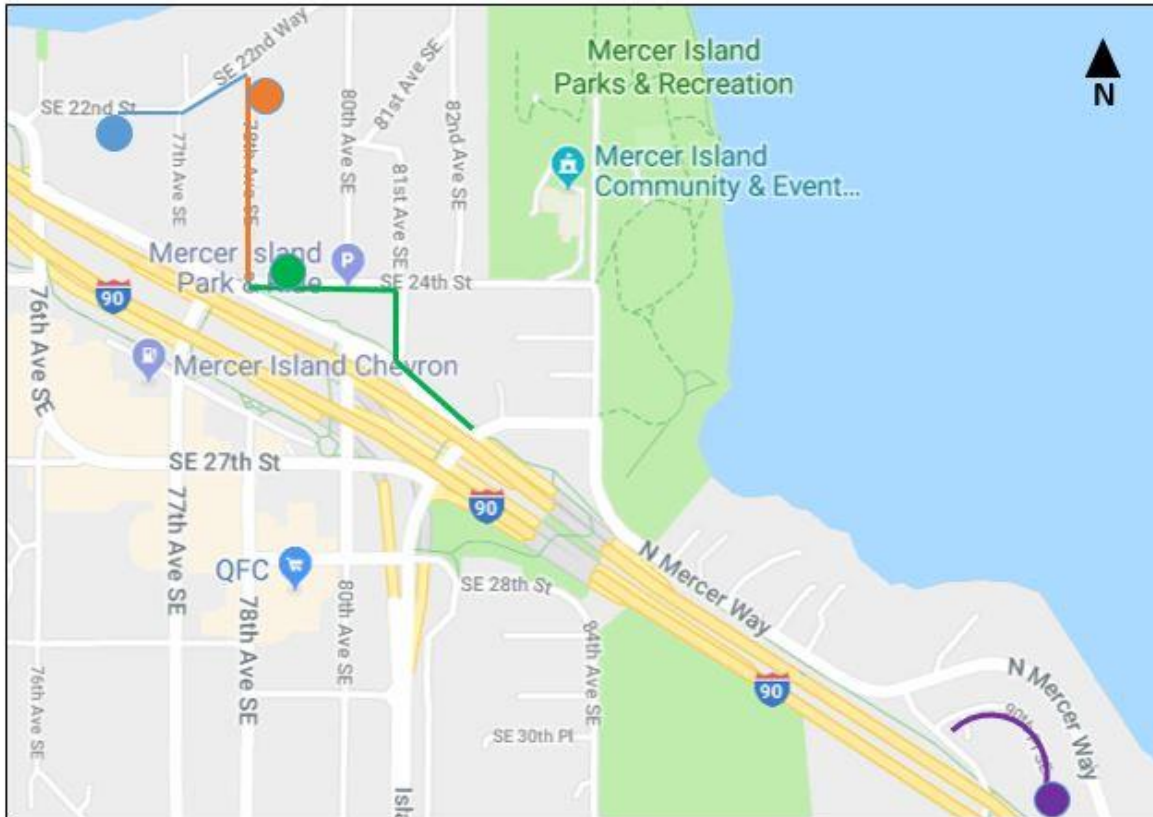
We’ll wrap up at 3 p.m. at the corner of 90th Place S.E. and Shorewood Drive (B).
