



## Construction Update – September 25, 2017

### *New sewer line installation continues along Southeast 35th Place*

Last week, crews started installing the new force main sewer line along S.E. 35th Pl. Work started near the intersection at 164th Avenue Southeast and crews are moving west towards Southeast Eastgate Way. Work to install the new sewer line in this area is expected to continue through early October.

This work is part of the County’s project to upgrade the Sunset and Heathfield pump stations and related sewer pipes that send sewage from Sammamish, Issaquah, and Bellevue to King County’s treatment plant in Renton.

#### **Extended work hours**

King County’s contractor received approval from the City of Bellevue to work extended hours each day to minimize the overall amount of days for this work on S.E. 35th Pl. Crews will be working weekdays from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

#### **What to Expect:**

- Work on weekdays between 7 a.m. – 5 p.m.
- Temporary and intermittent single-lane closures on S.E. 35th Pl.
- For some homes, work may cross the driveway and access may be blocked intermittently during work hours
  - If you need to travel in or out of your driveway during that time, crews will accommodate you, however it could take several minutes for crews to make the necessary adjustments
- Signs and flaggers to direct traffic around work
- When crews are not working in the street, they will temporarily patch and re-open affected lanes to traffic
- Expect some traffic delays when driving through the area
- Equipment, dust and noise close to the work areas
