Construction Update: *Cancelled weekend closure on Southeast 35th Place and extended closure planned on 164th Place Southeast*

Southeast 35th Place Weekend Closure CANCELLED

This weekend's closure of Southeast 35th Place between Southeast Eastgate Way and 164th Place Southeast has been cancelled. You will see this update reflected in the signs along the road later today.

As soon as the closure is rescheduled, we will let you know.

164th Place Southeast road closure (approximately 8 – 10 weeks) Beginning as early as 7 a.m. on Monday, July 30

Crews have been working on the first jack-and-bore pit near the Heathfield Pump Station for the past few weeks. To install a pipe via jack-and-bore, crews must dig a second pit so that they can drill a hole between the two pits and insert the pipe. To excavate the second jack-and-bore pit, crews will close a short section of 164th Place Southeast, from Vasa Creek to the intersection with Southeast 35th Street (shown on the map below). This area of 164th Place Southeast is scheduled to be closed for approximately 8 to 10 weeks as the pit will be too large to safely cover with steel plates.



The schedule and duration for construction is tentative and is subject to change as work progresses. We will continue to provide email notices with updates on timing of specific construction activities.

What you can expect:

- **Full road closure of 164th Place Southeast** near Southeast 35th Street. People driving will need use the posted detour route (see map).
- **Continued single-lane closures on Southeast 35th Place** to install the pipe via open cut.
- **Increased noise and activity at the Heathfield Pump Station:** Crews will prepare for jack-and-bore pipe installation by excavating and stabilizing pits near the pump station.
- **Work hours:** weekdays 6:30 a.m. to 7 p.m. (equipment will not start until 7 a.m.)
- **Increased noise and vibrations:** Neighbors can expect noise and vibrations from excavation for pit creation, shoring, boring machines, vector trucks, pipe installation, and generators.
- **Parking impacts:** Select street parking will be removed during this phase of work. Please adhere to the no parking signs posted by the contractor.
- **Access maintained for services:** Access will be maintained for emergency services, waste pickup, and mail delivery. Crews may need to temporarily move mailboxes approximately 100 feet from their original location. Residents should not have issues receiving mail during periods of temporary mailbox relocation.
