# Sunset and Heathfield Pump Stations and Force Main Upgrade

Feb. 20, 2019

## ***Thirty (30) minute rolling road closure on Thursday, Feb. 21; work is weather dependent.***

On Thursday Feb. 19, crews will be moving a generator from Vasa Park to the Heathfield Pump Station via West Lake Sammamish Parkway SE, SE 34th St, and 164th PI SE. The vehicle carrying the generator will move very slowly and will require a 30-minute rolling road closure. Once the generator reaches the Heathfield Pump Station, crews will prevent traffic from entering or exiting 163<sup>rd</sup> Ave SE for approximately 30 minutes.

***This work is weather dependent; the duration, route, date and times are subject to change.***

What to expect:

- This work will take place after the morning commute.
- Rolling closure resulting in traffic delays along delivery route.
- No vehicle access in or out of 163<sup>rd</sup> Ave SE while the generator is moved into the pump station driveway.
- If the date changes, we will send an email update with the new schedule.
