

March 21, 2019 Reminder: Upcoming road closures on SE 35th PI and SE Eastgate Way; repaving of 164th PI SE

Crews are preparing for two upcoming closures for the Sunset-Heathfield project. In addition, crews are working to pave 164th PI SE in preparation to open the road to traffic.

SE 35th PI Full Closure – Friday evening through Monday morning

Closure and work hours: work will take place during the day and overnight from 8 p.m. Friday, March 22 until 5 a.m. Monday, March 25.

Crews will close a small segment of SE 35th PI near the intersection of 164th PI SE to install pipe using open cut.

Eastgate lane and off-ramp closures – overnight work beginning Monday evening

Closure and work hours: 8 p.m. – 5 a.m., Monday, March 25 through Thursday, March 28.

Crews will install underground fiber optic cables across SE Eastgate Way, near the 161st Ave SE off-ramp from I-90, to support the new control systems for the Pump Stations. This will require single-lane closures as well as the closure of the off-ramp

Please note: the off-ramp will be closed to traffic during overnight work and drivers should use the 150th Ave SE off-ramp for the duration of nighttime work.


164th PI SE – paving

Crews are working this week and next to pave 164th PI SE in preparation to open the street to traffic.

Please note: Paving is highly weather dependent and may take longer than planned if crews do not have consistent dry weather conditions. In addition, once the road opens to traffic, crews will still need to close single lanes, as needed, to complete final restoration of the street.

A reminder of what to expect:

- **Increased noise and vibrations:** Neighbors can expect noise and vibrations from open cut pipe installation and vacuum trucks.
- Lights on SE 35th PI: Lights will be used to illuminate the worksite overnight.
- Flaggers and signage: Crews will assist drivers in detouring around closures. Access to homes and driveways will be maintained and prioritized for the duration of closures.
- Access maintained for services: Access will be maintained for emergency services, waste pickup, and mail delivery.

The schedule and duration for construction is tentative and is subject to change as work progresses. We will continue to provide email notices with updates on timing of specific construction activities.
