## Construction Update: Road restoration to begin as soon as Monday, July 22

King County's contractor will conduct final testing of the pipe the week of July 15. If the pipe passes the pressure test, the contractor will re-open 164th PI SE to through traffic.


From Monday, July 22 through Friday, July 26 the contractor plans to implement single-lane closures along 164th PI SE and portions of 163rd Ave E. During these closures, they will begin grinding, paving and patching the road. Please note that the timing of this work is dependent on weather conditions and can only begin once the pipe passes final testing.

### What to expect during grinding and paving:

- Work hours: 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on weekdays and weekends.
- **Single lane closures:** starting Monday July 22, on 164th PI SE and portions of 163rd Ave E. One lane will always remain open to allow traffic to pass through the area. Crews and signage will assist drivers in detouring around closures.
- **Driveway restrictions:** There will be limited driveway access during paving and grinding. If the contractor needs to block access to your driveway, they will contact you directly with additional details.
- Access maintained for services: Access will be maintained for emergency services, waste pickup, and mail delivery.
- **Increased noise and vibrations:** During construction hours, you may experience increased noise and vibrations from the grinding and paving process.
- Rough pavement following grinding: After grinding, there may be rough pavement and steel plates on the roadway until the paving is completed.
