Construction Update: Generator replacement pending equipment delivery

The Heathfield Pump Station is powered by Puget Sound Electric (PSE). If utility power is lost, the backup generators automatically activate to maintain operations. Crews will soon replace a generator at the Heathfield Pump Station.

Crews will need to use a crane to deliver the generator. This will likely mean more noise and traffic near the station during the work. *The timing for this work is dependent on the delivery of the equipment. We will post the work start date on the [project website](#) once we have it.*

Project Earns an Envision Silver Award for Sustainable Infrastructure



The Sunset and Heathfield Pump Station and Force Main Upgrade Project was awarded an Envision® Silver Award for project sustainability. The Envision rating system encourages sustainable, equitable, and resilient design, construction, operations, and maintenance processes and practices throughout a project's lifecycle.

Some of the sustainability efforts that contributed to the Envision Silver Award include:

Protecting the natural world. Restoring habitats by creating bat houses, root wads, brush piles, snags, and additional drainage swales, implementing a green roof and a rain garden, and using only native vegetation for landscaping.

Contributing to local skills development by hiring one in five apprentices from a state-recognized pre-apprenticeship program.
