COAL CREEK SEWER UPGRADE

July 15, 2019

Upper West Trailhead at Coal Creek Natural Area Closed July 29 & 30

King County Wastewater Treatment Division's contractor will carry out geotechnical investigations at the Upper West Trailhead at Coal Creek Natural Area. Geotechnical surveys in the current series include work at the trailhead on Monday and Tuesday, July 29 and 30, and upcoming work on the trail, expected in September (see map on reverse). These surveys will inform project design for the Coal Creek Sewer Upgrade Project.

Crews will use a truck-mounted drill rig to take samplings of soil and groundwater conditions below the road surface. In September, a smaller drill rig will be used for work on the trail. We will provide an update when that work is scheduled.



What to expect during this work

There will be no access through the work area from Forest Drive SE, SE 60th Street, or the trail from Red Town Trailhead.

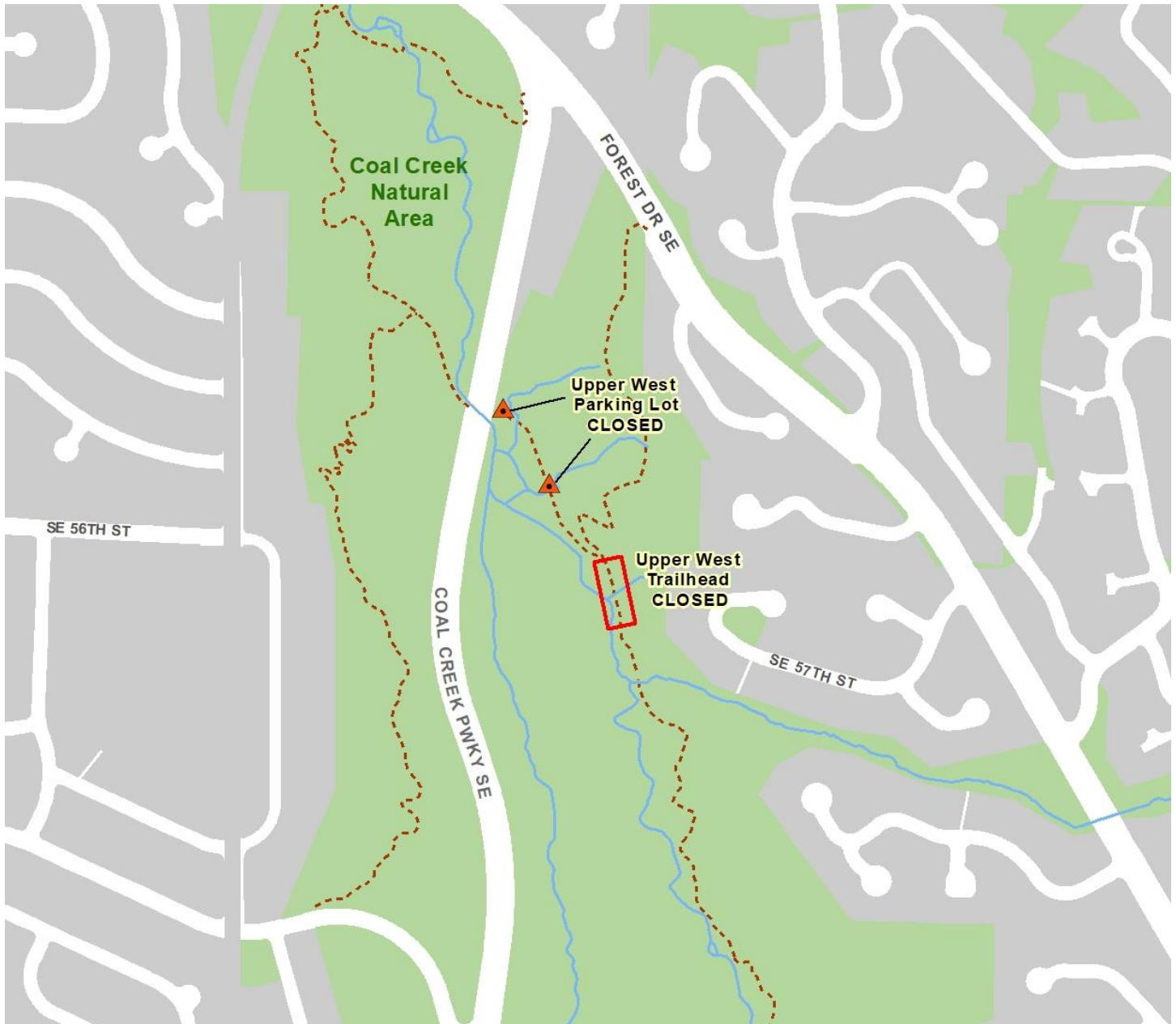

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About the project

King County WTD is designing a new sewer line to replace an existing line that runs under the Coal Creek Natural Area. The existing 2.5-mile long pipe provides service to Bellevue and Newcastle. The north section is nearing maximum capacity. The new pipe will serve Bellevue and Newcastle communities for another 50 years or more.
