KingCounty North Creek Interceptor Sewer Project

Update – Dec. 1, 2017

Update: street repairs and paving and along 14th Dr. SE between 208th St. SE to 13th Dr. SE

Beginning the week of Monday, December 4th, King County's contractor will start final restoration along 14th Drive SE from 208th Street SE on the south to just south of 13th Drive SE on the north for.

Work will include concrete repairs to sidewalks, curbs and driveways, and asphalt paving to portions of the road. It is expected that during the work there will be both:


- traffic control allowing one lane of traffic, and also
- a full street closure during final paving, when traffic will be detoured to 13th Dr. SE.

Signs will be posted on 208th St. SE to announce the closure and detours.

Flaggers and signs will direct motorists, pedestrians, and bicyclists during the closure. Restoration is expected to take about three weeks to complete (paving may be later).

What to expect:

- Work hours will be 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. weekdays, though any street closure could remain in place after work hours.
- Local access will be provided for residents on 14th Dr. SE during curb and sidewalk work.
- At times large equipment will be maneuvering in the road.
- Alternate pedestrian access will be provided as needed on 14th Dr. SE.
- Please use caution and obey the speed limit as crews complete this work.
