Continued Restoration work on 20th Ave. SE

On Thursday, January 17, King County’s contractor will do exploratory work, including potholing, along 20th Avenue SE just north of 220th Street SE. This work is scheduled to last one day.

Work will be taking place in the travel lanes on the east side of 20th Ave. SE.

Traffic will be reduced to one shared lane (alternating north and south); flaggers and signage will direct traffic through the work area.

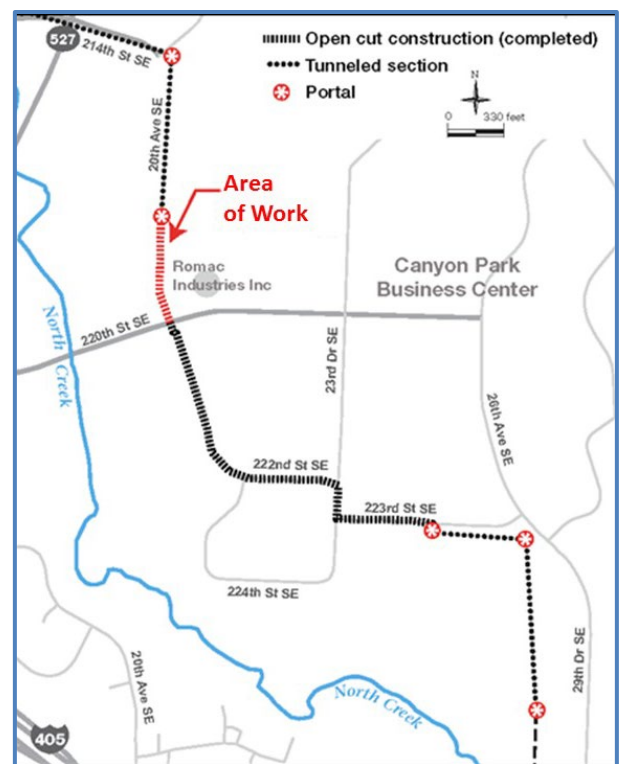
This work will include exploratory potholing being done in conjunction with continued restoration for the project.

- Work hours will be 9:00 am to 3:00 pm.
- Commuters may experience short delays during this work.
- Driveways to businesses near this work will remain open.
- Walkways and crossings will be provided for pedestrians as needed.
