## The Clean Water Plan SEPA scoping public comment period and online open house will close July 19

Reminder: If you haven't had a chance to visit our <u>online open house in English</u> or <u>Spanish</u>, we encourage you to do so. This online open house was designed to invite comments during the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) scoping period. During SEPA scoping, agencies, tribes, and the public are invited to comment on the scope of the draft environmental impact statement (EIS) for the Clean Water Plan.

On May 20, 2020, King County Wastewater Treatment Division (WTD) issued a Determination of Significance and Request for Comments on the Scope of the Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement (EIS). This formally began the SEPA scoping public comment period for the Clean Water Plan.
