



Drainage study in your neighborhood as early as July 16

King County crews will work on your street to continue studying soil, groundwater, surface water flow and street conditions.

What to expect:


- Starting the week of July 16, crews will pump water into pre-installed wells and measure the water level inside. Exact dates may change.
- A water truck and other equipment will be in the street and public right-of-way between the curb and the sidewalk.
- When testing is finished, the well will be covered with a steel disk that is flush with the ground.
- Temporary “No Parking” signs will give at least three days’ notice of parking restrictions for work days. *Signs will be left in the planting strip throughout July but will only prevent parking on work days.*
- Work will take place on weekdays between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.
- Expect noise levels typical of a construction site.
- In rare circumstances during work, the street may be blocked for several minutes. At some locations, pedestrian traffic may be re-routed.
