| <p><b>Registration deadlines</b></p> <p>While you may register to vote at any time, there are registration deadlines prior to each election. The deadlines for the April 26, 2016, special election:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>March 28</b> – Deadline to register to vote online or by mail, or update existing voter registration information.</li> <li>• <b>April 18</b> – In-person registration deadline for people not currently registered in Washington. Register in person at the King County Elections office or at the Voter Registration Annex.</li> </ul> <p><b>Keep your voter registration current</b></p> <p>Update your registration if you have moved or changed your name, or if your signature has changed.
