


How to file as a PCO candidate




 File online May 16 – 20, 2022

 **Redistricting has caused precincts to change. Please check your precinct on the [King County District Finder](#) after March 24 to find your current precinct.**

To become a candidate for precinct committee officer (PCO), you must be:

- Registered to vote in the precinct you're filing to run in
- At least 18 years old by the Primary (August 2)

 **Before you file:** Verify your voter registration information on [My Voter Information](#). If you need update your address or other information immediately before filing, call King County Elections at 206-296-1565.


Three ways to file:


Recommended

1) Online – this is the fastest and easiest way to file. [Online filing](#) opens at 9 a.m. on May 16 and is available 24 hours a day until Friday, May 20 at 4 p.m.


2) By Mail – If you will be without access to a computer during the week of May 16-20, you can file by mail starting on May 2. Filings by mail must be received by May 20 at 4:30 p.m., regardless of the postmark.


3) In Person – King County Elections encourages only those who need additional assistance to file in person. [Elections HQ](#) will be open during business hours from 8:30 a.m. on May 16 to 4:30 p.m. on May 20.

 **Will my name appear on the ballot?** Only positions with two or more filed candidates will appear on the August Primary ballot. When a position has only one filed candidate, that person is considered elected.

 **Find out who else has filed for PCO on our website.** A listing of all filed candidates will be updated at noon and 6 p.m. during the week of candidate filing. The final list of candidates will be posted on Tuesday, May 24 after Monday's deadline to withdraw.
