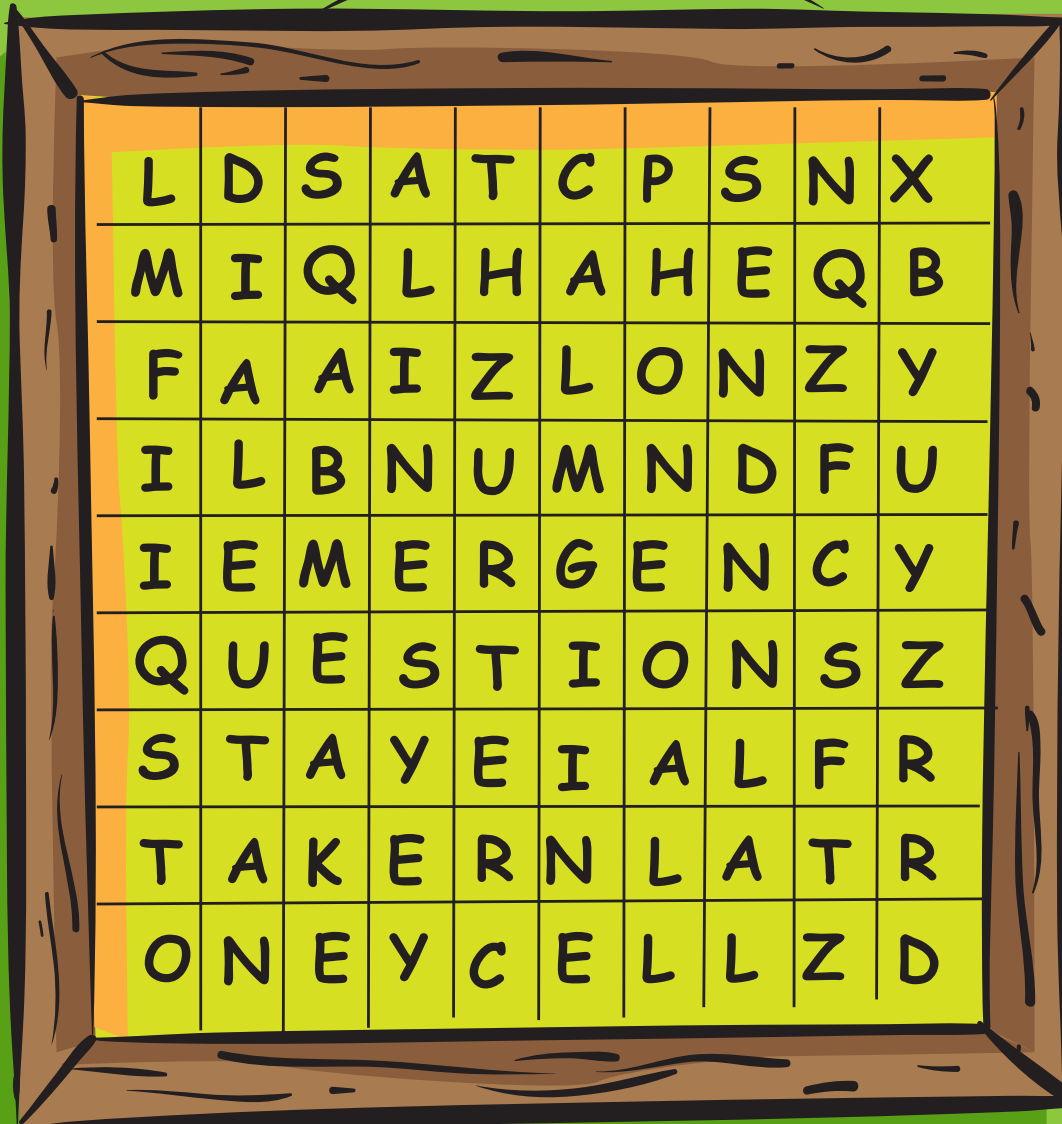

Learn about 9-1-1 with Emery

Help Emery find the words in **BOLD** so he's sure you know how to call 9-1-1 in an emergency!

If you have an **emergency**, you can dial 9-1-1 (**Nine one one**) from any phone. If the phone has a cord, just pick it up and **dial**. If the **phone** doesn't have a cord, turn it **on** and dial. If the phone is a **cell** phone, find the keypad, dial 9-1-1 and press **send**. When you call do not hang up! **Stay** on the **line**, be **calm**, and answer for the 9-1-1 **call** taker's **questions**. The call **taker** will tell you when it's safe to hang up.
