Crime Reduction Initiative


- Reduction in Police Resources 2010
- Sharp increase in Violent Crime 2011-2012
- Police Proposed CRI
 - Targeted Tukwila International Boulevard (TIB)
 - Included Hot Spots Strategy
- Mayor and Council Approved





Urban Renewal Area


- Council Ordinance in 2000
- States Community Renewal Law RCW 35.81
- Purpose was to eliminate blight through revitalization
- > Authorization granted April 2013 to purchase motels





Community Renewal RCW 35.81

- Allows the creation of urban renewal areas within cities to revive areas struggling with crime and blight.
- Purpose to eliminate social liabilities, increase growth, reduce crime and improve livability.
- Redevelopment can occur through acquisition of blighted areas; demolition and removal of buildings and improvements; making land available for development or redevelopment by private enterprise or public bodies.





Council Condemnation Action

- Crime and disorder at motels on TIB
 - Hotel/Motel Ordinance
 - Chronic Nuisance Ordinance
 - Uncooperative Ownership
- Increase PD staff or change the environment
- Condemnation Initiated Under URA April 2013










Motel Police Investigation












- Regional effort between the valley agencies and ATF identified a pattern associated with these motels
- Local efforts recognized the same trends
 - Hotel owners and managers charging fees for entry onto their properties to solicit drugs and prostitution
 - Facilitation of EBT (food stamp) fraud by hotel management
 - A common ownership group between the three motels (Travelers Choice, Boulevard, Great Bear)





- Formalized partnership with ATF and United States Attorney's Office
- Focused motel activity
 - Confidential sources and undercover officers confirmed management/ownership profited from the criminal activity
 - U.S. Attorney's Office Adopted the Case
 - Federal prosecution
 - Civil forfeiture of properties








Humanitarian Effort

- Riverton United Methodist Church
- Multi-department effort
- Sound Mental Health support
- Food, emergency supplies, Visa cards, bus tickets, information
- Detailed intakes conducted, motel arrangements made, transportation arranged









Post Operation

- All three owners plead guilty to conspiracy to maintain drug involved properties
- One year in federal prison/three years probation
- All interest in the three motels were forfeited
- > 6,000 square foot SeaTac home seized and forfeited
- > \$255,000.00 profited from criminal activity was seized from their homes and bank accounts
- 2007 Mercedes Benz forfeited




Outcomes


