Revised Local Route 930 - Phase 3

Neighborhoods Served:

- Kingsgate Park and Ride, Totem Lake Transit Center, Willows Rd, Redmond Transit Center, Redmond Town Center

Summary of Proposed Changes:

- Add service on nights and weekends.
- The Phase 3 proposal adds service on Sunday on this route.
- This change will occur in 2024 with the opening of Link Light Rail to Downtown Redmond.

Why is this change being proposed?

- To improve local connections to Link light rail.

How does this respond to feedback Metro received in Phase 1 and Phase 2?

- Improve and add local connections.
- More service on nights and weekends.

* Frequent - The bus comes every 15 minutes or less during peak periods and every 30 minutes or less during off-peak periods.

* Local – All-day bus service that does not meet the standard for frequent.

* Peak-only – The bus comes only 5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. These are the times of day Metro and Sound Transit sees the most riders, usually regular commuting times, Monday through Friday.
