## How might my bus be changing?

Proposed changes respond to the following needs:



More east-west connections



Provide transit services where needs are greatest



Bus runs later into the night



More bus trips on weekends

- Provides new east-west, frequent, all-day bus service between Lake City, Northgate and Greenwood, replacing the portion of current Route 20 that has the highest ridership and serves equity priority areas between Lake City and Licton Springs.
- 70% of weekday rider activity on the current Route 20 takes place between Lake City and Licton Springs, while the portion of Route 20 between Green Lake and U District accounts for 30%. This change would put more bus service where needs are greatest.
- Route 61 requires further coordination with the City of Seattle.
