



# North Link Connections Mobility Project

## Route 62 - Revised

## **Neighborhoods Served:**

 Sand Point, Ravenna, Bryant, Roosevelt, Wallingford, Fremont, South Lake Union, Downtown Seattle

# **Summary of Proposed Changes:**

- Revise route to operate on NE 65<sup>th</sup> Street, Latona Avenue NE and N/NE 56<sup>th</sup> Street between NE 65<sup>th</sup> Street/Ravenna Boulevard NE and Meridian Avenue N/N 56<sup>th</sup> Street. Service along the previous routing would be replaced by new Routes 23 and 25.
- Begin all morning trips at Sand Point.

# Why is this change being proposed?

- Reduce the amount of bus service along Kirkwood Place N where service is negatively affecting residents.
- To improve speed and reliability of service between Roosevelt and Wallingford.
- Improve connections to Link light rail.
- Simplify service in the NE 65<sup>th</sup> Street corridor by providing one very frequent route.

#### How often the bus would come:

- Service Level: Frequent
- Days of Operation: Weekdays, Saturdays and Sunday

#### How does this respond to feedback Metro received in Phase 1?

- Improves connections to Link light rail
- Improve east-west connections
- Simplify service design for easier understanding
