# Metro Route 120 is becoming RapidRide H Line in 2022

King County Metro, in partnership with the Seattle Department of Transportation and the City of Burien, is working to upgrade Metro Bus Route 120—one of our 10 busiest routes—to RapidRide H Line.

Starting in 2022, RapidRide H Line, connecting Burien and White Center to Downtown Seattle/South Lake Union through the Delridge neighborhood, will improve travel times, reliability, and connections to other buses and Link light rail.

### Enhanced stations

RapidRide bus stops, called stations, provide riders with more amenities and a faster way to travel and board the bus. Upgrades include:

- ▶ Stations located approximately one-third of a mile apart to help speed up travel times
- ▶ New shelters, ORCA card readers, lighting, real-time travel information, additional seating, and all-door boarding
- ▶ Stations easily accessed from local businesses and community gathering spaces

### Increased safety and access

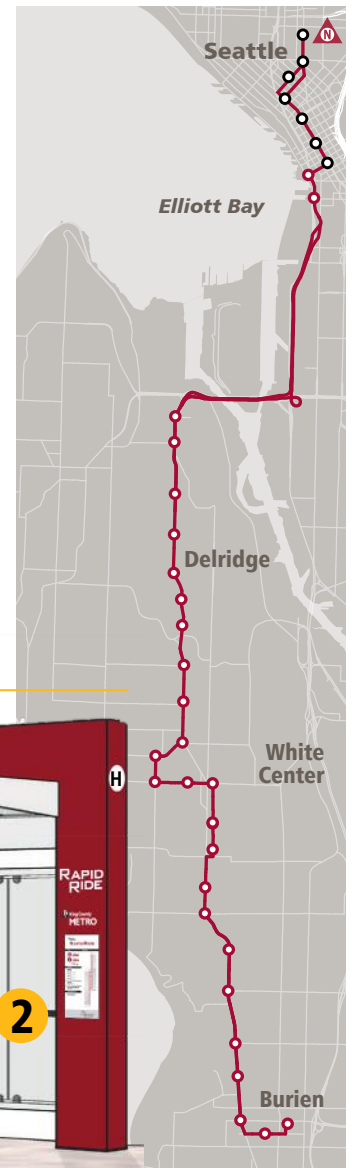
RapidRide upgrades will make it easier and safer to walk and roll to the bus. Improvements include:

- ▶ New pedestrian crossing signals and crosswalks
- ▶ New sidewalks, sidewalk repairs and ADA-compliant ramps

### Improved speed and reliability

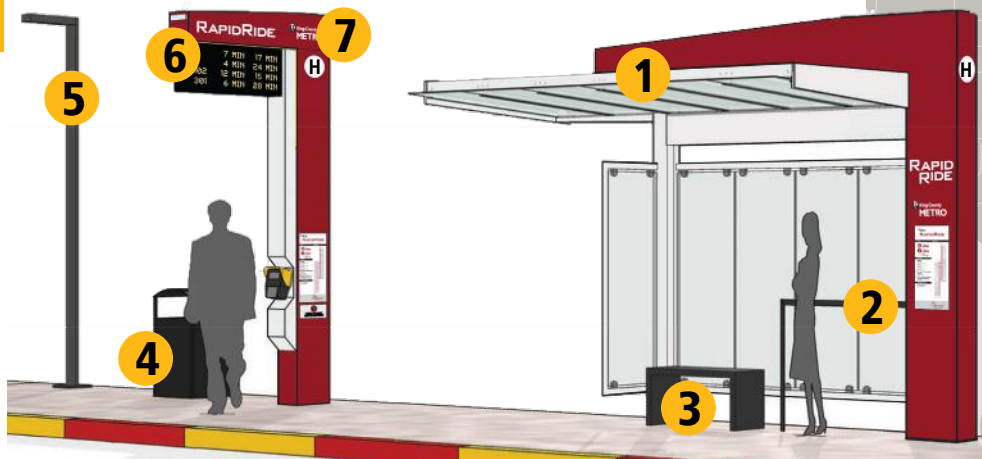
Riders can expect a decrease in travel time with RapidRide upgrades. Additional service improvements include:

- ▶ More frequent buses—every 15 minutes all day, every day and at least every 10 minutes during peak travel times
- ▶ Business access and transit (BAT) lanes
- ▶ Priority bus signals
- ▶ Burien roadway improvements include a new center turn lane, left turn lanes and a new traffic signal

## Construction starts as soon as spring 2021!

Before RapidRide service begins on the new route, Metro will construct safety improvements throughout the corridor and upgrade bus stations with RapidRide shelters and amenities. We'll reach out to route neighbors and users in advance of construction to notify them of the work and any impacts.

### During construction, you can expect:

- ▶ Some sidewalk, intersection, and lane closures
- ▶ Detours and temporary stop relocations for Route 120
- ▶ Typical impacts, such as noise, dust, and truck activity
