Night Stop Program

For your added safety at night, you may request to exit the bus at a location along your route other than a regular bus stop. To do so, please go to the front of the bus and ask your driver at least one block before your desired stop. Safety considerations will determine if the driver can comply with your request. Night Stop service is available only from 8 pm to 5 am and is for dropping off riders only. Night Stop is not provided in downtown Seattle.

How to Pay

At all times, pay your fare **when you board** the bus. Pay with cash (exact fare; drivers do not carry change), ticket or with a convenient regional ORCA card. Show your activated Transit GO Ticket (mobile ticket) or valid transfer to the driver. Metro transfers are valid on Metro, only. See “How to pay” on Metro’s website for more information.

Route 906 Service Information

Fairwood accessible dial-a-ride transit (DART) offers you two transportation services: fixed and (limited) variable routing.

Route 906 provides DART service in portions of the Fairwood area (see map) at the following times:

- Mon-Fri (except holidays) 6 am – 11:30 pm
- Sat-Sun 8:20 am - 7 pm

Reservations / Variable Routing

You can request off-route trips on DART within the DART service area by calling the DART reservation office. You need to make your trip request at least two hours before you want to be picked up, and you can make your reservations for 30 days at a time, up to 30 days in advance. Reservations will be taken on a first-come, first-served basis.

Reservations can be made by calling **1-866-261-3278 (voice)**, or **1-800-246-1646 (TTY)** during the following hours:

- Monday-Friday 5 am - 11 pm
- Saturday 7:30 am - 9:30 pm
- Sunday/Holidays 9:30 am - 6:30 pm

A limited number of off-route deviations, only, can be made on any given trip. Vans can deviate from their fixed routes to serve other locations within the service area, but they can not necessarily provide door-to-door service due to safety and other operational considerations (narrow streets, cul-de-sacs, etc.). You may need to board/deboard at a location a block or more away from the location you requested.

Scheduled Service/ Fixed Routing

DART vans provide hourly service at Metro bus stops along the route (see schedule for times). Every trip serves Southcenter and the Valley Medical Center, where you can transfer to other Metro routes. For more information, call Metro’s Rider Information at 206-553-3000.

At Metro’s Customer Service Office you can buy ORCA cards, bus passes, senior permits and taxi scrip, get information about bus service, register for disability permits and retrieve items turned into Lost & Found. Customer Service hours may change in response to public health guidance.

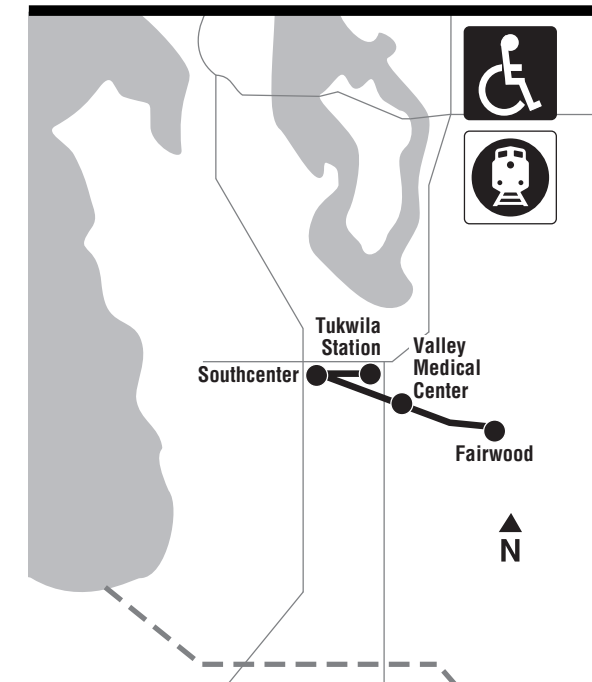

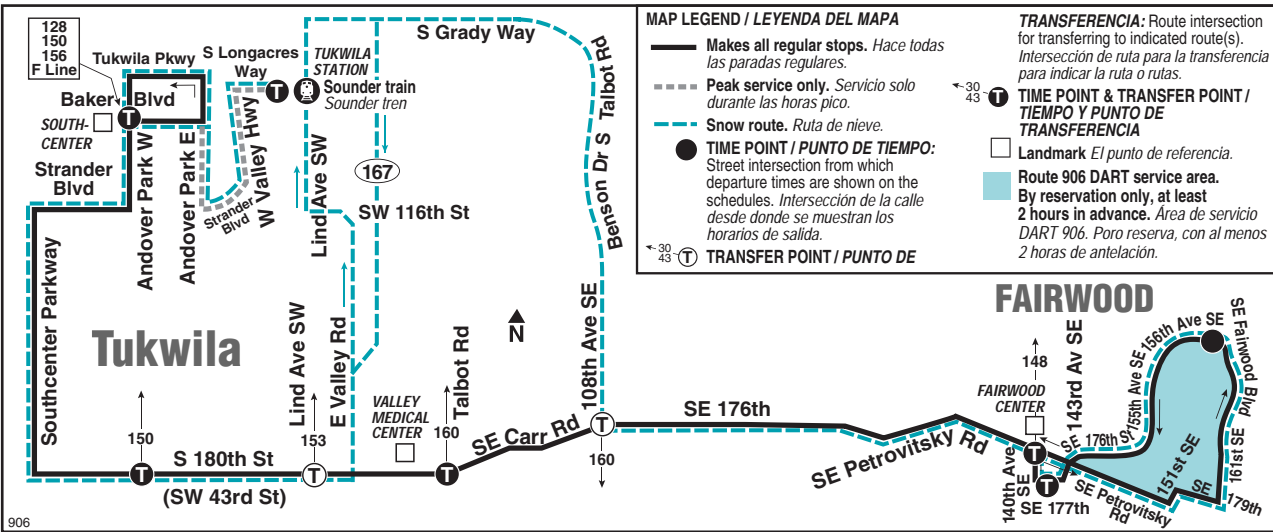

Snow/Emergency Service Servicio de emergencia/nieve

During most snow conditions this route will operate via the snow routing shown in this timetable. In the rare event that Metro declares an emergency, this route will continue to operate as a designated Emergency Snow Network route. During such an event, it is expected to operate with the same route number and follow the same snow routing as shown in this timetable.
