How To Pay

Upon boarding, pay your fare with exact change or a convenient regional ORCA card. ORCA cards are sold in downtown Seattle at Metro's customer service office in King Street Center (201 S. Jackson St).

Pay As You Board

At all times, pay your fare as you board the bus, be it cash, ticket or with a convenient ORCA card. Metro transfers are valid on Metro, only.

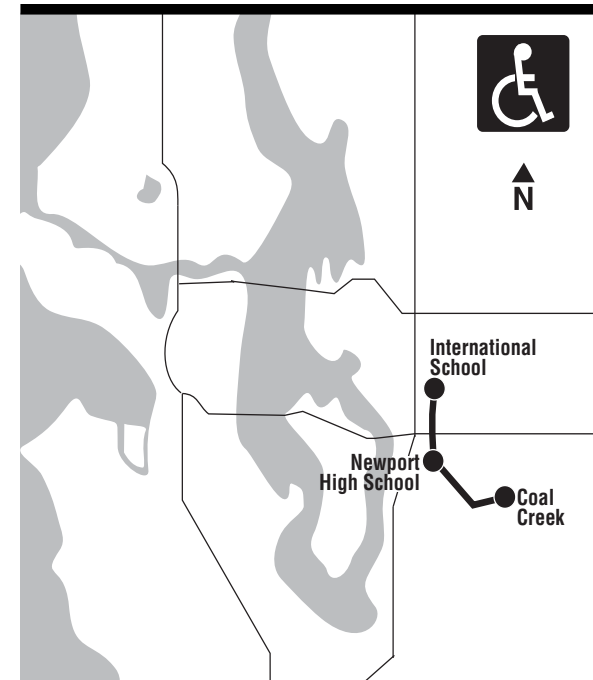

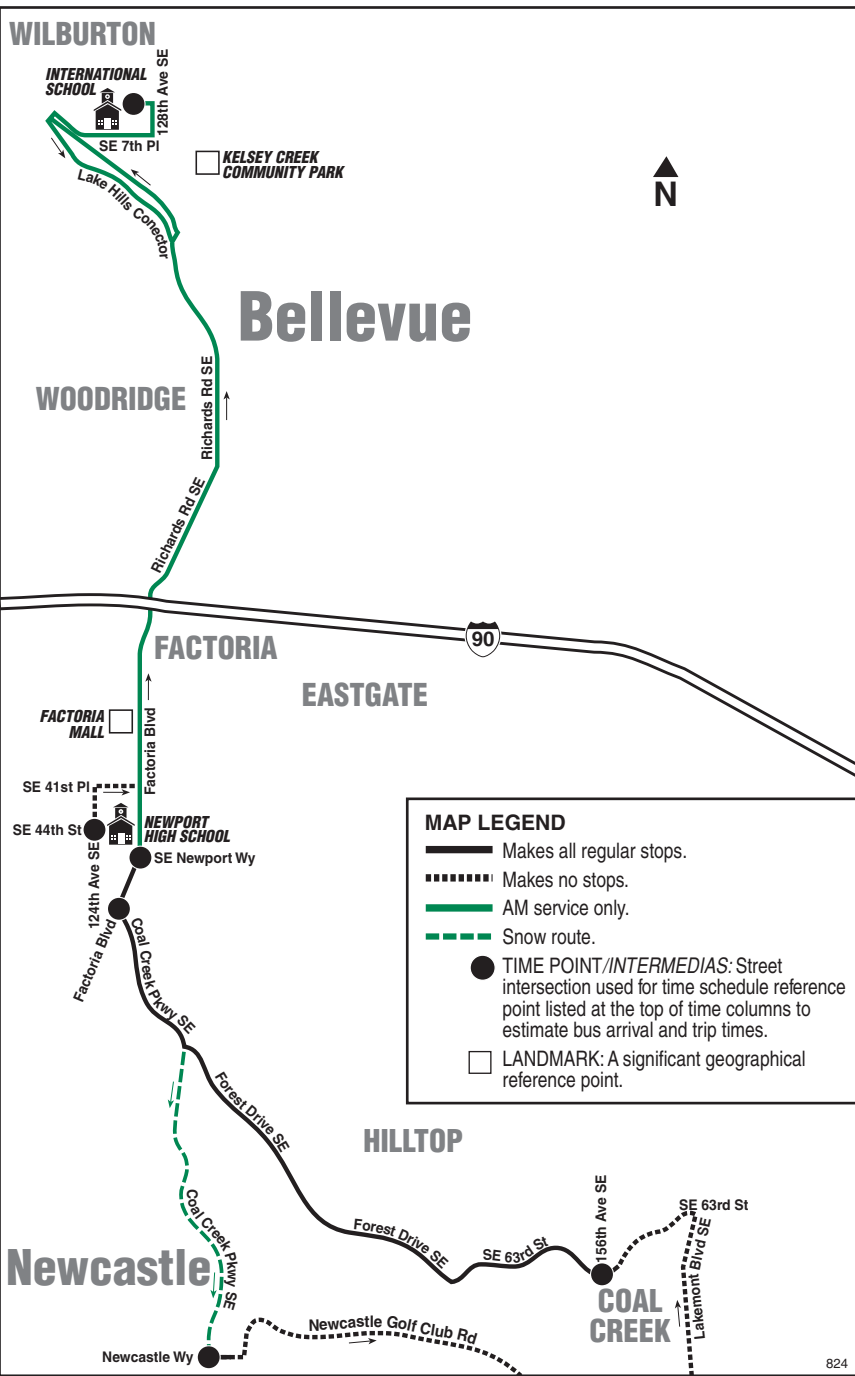

ORCA Card

Metro Transit and eight other Puget Sound transportation agencies (Community Transit, Everett Transit, Kitsap Transit, Pierce Transit, Sound Transit, Seattle Streetcar, King County Water Taxi and Washington State Ferries) use a common fare-payment system called ORCA (One Regional Card for All). The ORCA card works as cash or a pass, and it automatically tracks the value of your fares and transfers, letting you move easily between the participating transportation systems.

Get your ORCA card online at www.orcard.com, by phone at 1-888-988-6722 (ORCA) or TTY Relay: 711 (1-888-889-6368), at ticket vending machines in Sounder and Link rail stations, or at one of the transit agency customer service offices. The ORCA Web site also provides information on how to use the card, as well as locations at which they can be reloaded with a new pass or additional cash.

Adverse Weather Information Información meteorológica adversa

During adverse weather conditions when Metro can not safely negotiate certain roadways, Route 824 morning service will be canceled. If normal morning service transported students

to school and return service is needed in the afternoon, Route 824 will continue southbound on Coal Creek Pkwy SE and terminate at Coal Creek Pkwy SE & Newport Wy SE. Service will not be provided on Forest Dr SE to SE 63rd St & 156th Ave SE. In the rare event that Metro declares an emergency, this route will not operate. For additional snow route information, call Metro at 206-553-3000, or visit Metro at kingcounty.gov/metro. Sign up for Transit Alerts to stay informed during adverse conditions.

Durante las condiciones climáticas adversas cuando metro no puede negociar con seguridad ciertos caminos, el servicio matutino de Route 824 será cancelado. Si el servicio matutino normal transporta a los estudiantes a la escuela y el servicio de regreso es necesario por la tarde, la ruta 824 continuará hacia el sur en Carbon Creek Pkwy se y terminará en Coal Creek Pkwy se & Newport WY se. el servicio no será proporcionado en el bosque Dr se a se 63 St & 156 ave se. En el raro caso de que metro declare una emergencia, esta ruta no funcionará.
