

## November 2021 - DRIVER ALERT - Commuter Van Bulletin



Dear Metro Commuter Van Driver,

We are sending this message to make you aware there has been a recent increase in vandalism of King County vehicles. As a result, please be diligent in performing your daily Vanpool / Vanshare vehicle inspection and pay close attention for any new, previously unreported vehicle damage. As a reminder, the daily inspection is a simple, quick, visual check of the inside and outside of the vehicle for any signs of trouble.

It is essential to report defective equipment, new damage, and vehicle problems – or even suspected problems – to your Maintenance Rideshare Services Representative (MRSR) as soon as possible. When reporting, provide your name, group number, vehicle number, contact information, and a brief description of the issue or damage.

Finally, if any part of your inspection leads you to believe your vehicle is unsafe, **do not drive it** and wait for further direction from your MRSR.
