**Project Description**: Construction of a new single-family residence with associated site improvements and removal of existing structures. SEPA is required due to the wetland restoration proposal to remove the fill from the wetland and to restore the wetland which is considered as lands covered by water pursuant to WAC 197-11-756. The work is not categorically exempt from review pursuant to WAC 197-11-800(1)(a)(i).

**Consistency with applicable County plans and regulations**: This proposal will be reviewed for compliance with all applicable King County codes including, but not limited to Surface Water Design Manual, Zoning, Grading and Critical Areas Codes.

The King County Department of Local Services, Permitting Division, will issue an Environmental Threshold Determination pursuant to the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) on this application following a 24-day public comment period which ends on March 1, 2021. As such, the optional DNS/MDNS notice process is being used pursuant to WAC 197-11-355. The project review process may incorporate or require mitigation measures regardless of whether an EIS is prepared.
