Project Description: This grading permit is subject to SEPA review for the unpermitted excavation within an aquatic area, and to restore all disturbed Critical Areas as identified in the Code Enforcement Action ENFR15-0662. A Voluntary Compliance Agreement was required which in part requires a restoration plan to address the clearing violations, as well as a Farm Management Plan for access.

Permit requested in this application: Clearing & Grading Permit.

Environmental review is required and relevant environmental documents are available on-line at <u>www.kingcounty.gov/permits</u>, or at the above address.

Consistency with applicable County plans and regulations: This proposal will be reviewed for compliance with all applicable King County codes including Roads Standards, Surface Water Design Manual, Zoning, Grading and Critical Areas Codes.

Other permits not included in this application, known at this time: Future Temporary Use Permit to host wedding & events; Future Building permit to establish a distillery in existing barn; Future Critical Areas Alteration Exception to construct permanent parking. WA State HPA for possible future alterations to existing bridge over stream.

King County Code requires notification of property owners within at least 500 feet of the project proposed above, so they can obtain additional information about the proposal and comment if they wish (KCC 20.20).

The Department of Permitting and Environmental Review (DPER) will issue an Environmental Threshold Determination pursuant to the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) on this application following <u>a 24-day</u> <u>public comment period which ends on December 13, 2018</u>. The responsible official has a reasonable basis for expecting to issue a SEPA Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) on this project. As such, the optional DNS/MDNS notice process is being used pursuant to WAC 197-11-355. The project review process may incorporate or require mitigation measures regardless of whether an EIS is prepared.

This may be the only opportunity to comment on the environmental impacts of the proposal. Written comments on this application must be submitted to DPER at the address above by the end of the comment period.
