Project Description: The applicant is proposing to improve the Foothills Trail for approximately 1.2 miles from its current terminus at 252 nd Ave SE to the White River. The trail extension across the White River to connect to the existing Foothills Trail in Buckley, Pierce County, is outside King County jurisdiction.

However, the DPER decision may be appealed to the Shoreline Hearings Board, who would conduct an appeal hearing prior to making a decision on the appeal. Details of the appeal process will be included in the notice of decision.
