Project Location: I-405 corridor from mileposts 7.95 to 8.4 (between Bellevue, Newcastle and Renton)

Project Description: Widen I-405 to add an additional north and south travel lane and develop the Eastside Rail Corridor into a paved trail for bicycle and pedestrian use. *The project also includes construction of a noise attenuating wall along the west side of I-405. A portion of this widening project falls within unincorporated King County and within King County designated Shoreline jurisdiction. Impacts to shoreline ecological functions and critical area buffers within shoreline jurisdiction will be mitigated.
