Project Description: Replace existing private residential pier on Cottage Lake, consistent with King County Shoreline Master Program standards for new piers on freshwater lakes. The new pier will be 372 square feet (ft), 80 feet in length by 4 ft. wide for the first 54 ft. in length, and 6 ft. wide for the most waterward 26 ft. in length. The pier decking will consist of light-penetrating plastic grating and the pier will be supported by 14, 3.5-inch diameter steel piles. The existing pier will be removed.

Consistency with applicable County plans and regulations: This proposal will be reviewed for compliance with all applicable King County Codes (KCC), including the Shoreline Master Program (KCC 21A.25) and Critical Areas (KCC 21A.24).

The Department of Local Services (DLS) will issue a decision on this application following a minimum, 30day public comment period which ends April 13, 2020. Written comments on this application must be submitted to DPER at the address below. A public hearing is not required for this application prior to the DLS decision. However, the DPER decision may be appealed to the Shoreline Hearings Board, who would conduct an appeal hearing prior to making a decision on the appeal. Details of the appeal process will be included in the notice of decision.
