



# Fuel Tank Removal and Decommissioning Contractors, Application Information

The Department of Local Services, Permitting Division (Permitting) is responsible for review and approval of contractors that remove or decommission fuel tanks in unincorporated King County. Fuel tank contractors must be state licensed, approved by Permitting and employ ICC UST Certified staff to remove or decommission fuel tanks.

## Application Instructions

Submit a completed Fuel Tank Removal and Decommissioning Contractors, Application Form to [PermitServices@kingcounty.gov](mailto:PermitServices@kingcounty.gov). Your application will be screened, and a confirmation email will be sent to you with online payment instructions.

## Fuel Tank Permitting

As a licensed contractor with King County your company must:

1. Submit the tank decommission certification within 30 days after tank decommission through [MyBuildingPermit.com](http://MyBuildingPermit.com).
2. Comply with all provisions of Chapter 34 and Section 5704 of the International Code Council and requirements for decommissioning, abandonment, or removal of underground residential heating oil tanks.
