

Non-residential and multi-family mechanical systems permit checklist

The Department of Local Services, Permitting Division (Permitting) Non-residential Mechanical permit covers the installation, replacement, or relocation of mechanical systems such as furnaces, air conditioners, heat pumps, boilers, ducting, kitchen hoods and other HVAC equipment. For single family buildings and townhouses see Residential Mechanical Permits.

A separate non-residential mechanical permit is not necessary for new installations in conjunction with a non-residential construction or remodel permit, as the mechanical work is included as part of the building permit.

1	Site Plan, Basic site plan identifying location of work on site
1	Mechanical construction plans
1	Mechnical system specifications (if not on plans)
1	Energy code calculation <u>waenergycodes.com</u>
Copies	Other Submittal Documents (optional)
1	Building Floor Plan - may be required
1	Structural plans and calculations when modifications are made for additional loads
