



# Private Swimming Pool or Spa Instructions and Worksheet

**Exemption:** Prefabricated swimming pools accessory to a single-family residence, that are less than 24-inches deep, do not exceed 5,000 gallons, and are installed entirely above ground, are EXEMPT from permits.

## Seattle – King County Public Health Permits

**Public and Semi-Public Swimming pools, hot tubs or spas**, please refer to [Seattle – King County Public Health, Water Recreation Services](#) for permit application and review.

If the property is served by on-site sewage system (septic system), Public Health approval is required for the location of the pool. Prior to submission of a building permit application for the pool, contact Public Health to start the [Public Health permit application process](#).

Site Plan:

The site plan is required to give property dimensions, show any adjacent streets, indicate septic system location, if applicable, and show the position of the house on the lot. If a fence is used as part of the pool barrier, please identify its location on the site plan. The drawing must be representative of the lot. See the [Site Plan Requirements Handout](#).

Structural Plans/Working Drawings:

Two sets of complete construction drawings with engineering calculations or an approved ICC ES report demonstrating compliance with the 2015 International Residential Code. The specific layout of the pool and the Access Barrier drawn at ¼"=1 ft. scale is required.
