WHO NEEDS A RASKC PET LICENSE?

By law, a pet license is required for all dogs and cats 8 weeks of age or older kept in the **R**egional **A**nimal **S**ervices of **K**ing **C**ounty service area. This includes all cities except: Algona, Auburn, Bothell, Burien, Des Moines, Federal Way, Hunts Point, Medina, Normandy Park, Pacific, Renton, and Skykomish.

IMPORTANT RABIES INFORMATION

King County Code 11.04.520 requires all dogs and cats six months of age or older to be vaccinated against rabies. Although not required to obtain a RASKC pet license, current vaccination is important for your pet's protection and for public health concerns.

DISCOUNTED LICENSES

Discounted license are available to senior citizens 65 years of age and older and disabled persons who are licensing spayed and/or neutered pets. See the front of this application for spay/neuter proof options. First time licensees for disabled licenses must complete an eligibility form found on our website at www.kingcounty.gov/pets.
