



# North Link Connections Mobility Project

## Route 40 – Revised

### Neighborhoods Served:

- Northgate, Crown Hill, Loyal Heights, Fremont, Westlake, Downtown

### Summary of Proposed Changes:

- Modify route to operate on NE Northgate Way between Meridian Ave N and 5<sup>th</sup> Ave NE.

### Why is this change being proposed?

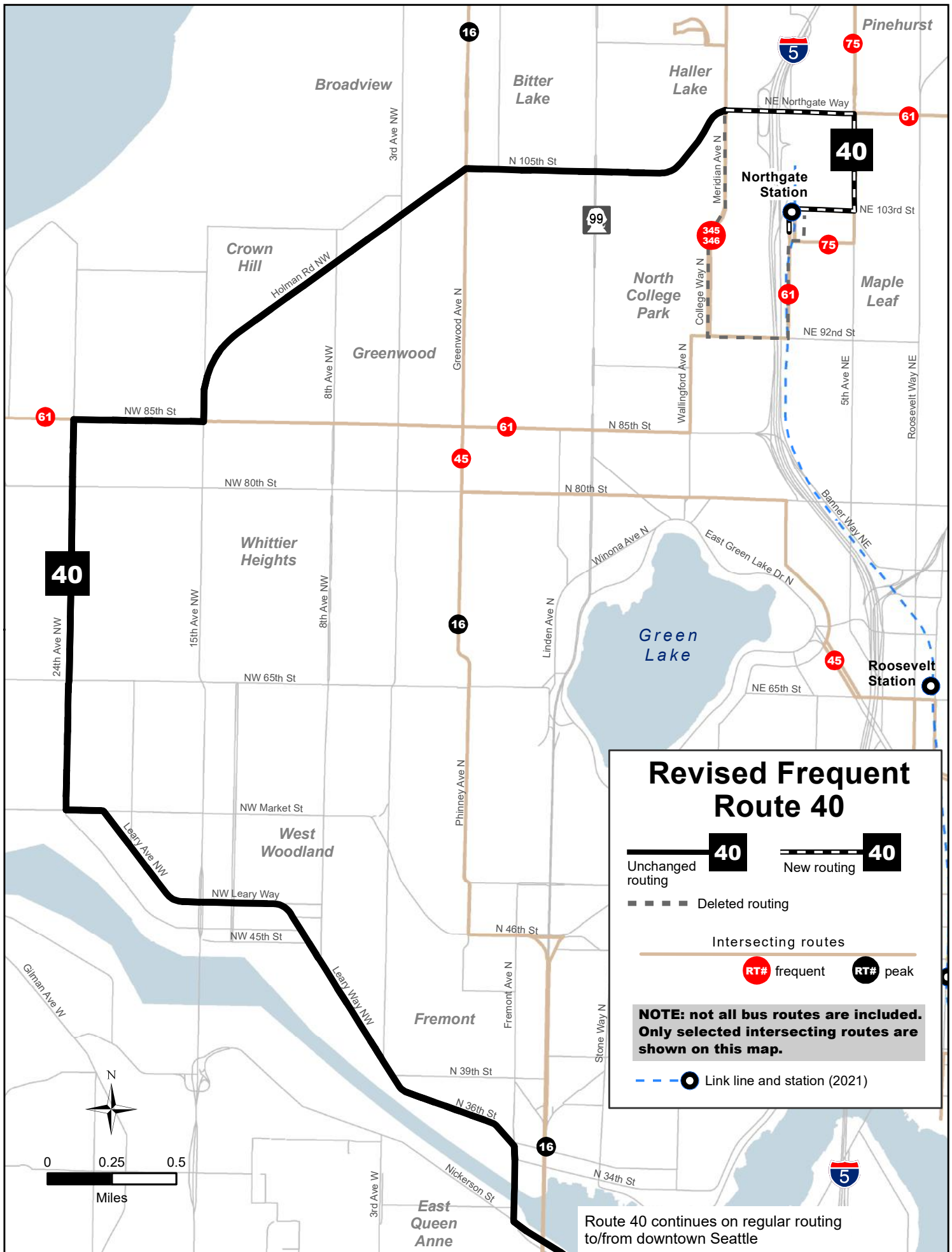
- To provide a new connection into the center of the Northgate urban center and provide connections to Routes 61, 67, 75, 347 and 348 without needing to go to Northgate Station.
- Service along Meridian Ave N via N 92<sup>nd</sup> St and 1<sup>st</sup> Ave NE to Northgate Station would continue to be provided by Routes 345 and 346.

### How often the bus would come:

- **Service Level: Frequent**
- **Days of Operation: Weekdays, Saturdays and Sundays**

### How does this respond to feedback Metro received in Phase 1?

- Improves connections to Link light rail
- Improves east-west connections
- Simplifies service design for easier understanding
