



# North Link Connections Mobility Project

## Route 45 - Revised

### Neighborhoods Served:

- Greenwood, Green Lake, Roosevelt, University District

### Summary of Proposed Changes:

- Shortened route to no longer travel east of 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE along NE Pacific Street and terminate at the west side of the UW Medical Center.
- Revise service in Green Lake to serve Woodlawn Avenue NE and 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue NE instead of Green Lake Drive.
- Operate on N 80<sup>th</sup> Street instead of N 85<sup>th</sup> Street between Greenwood Avenue N and 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue NE.
- Terminate route in Greenwood instead of Loyal Heights.
  - Service to be replaced by new Route 61.
- Serves Greenwood, the University District, Green Lake and Roosevelt neighborhoods.
- Route connects to the Roosevelt and U District Link light rail stations.

### Why is this change being proposed?

- To improve reliability by avoiding traffic congestion along NE Pacific Street, Wallingford Avenue N, and N 85<sup>th</sup> Street.
- Serve more residents in the Green Lake area.
- Provide new east-west service along N 80<sup>th</sup> Street.
