

Route 250

Avondale – Redmond – Kirkland – Bellevue
Proposed new route (March 2020)

Summary

- New frequent route connecting Redmond, Kirkland, the South Kirkland Park-and-Ride, and Bellevue.
- Would provide replacement service for deleted routes 234, 235, and 248.
- During peak periods and midday, new Route 250 would operate more frequently (buses would come more often) than existing Route 248 on weekdays.
- When operating at 15-minute frequency, every other trip would end at the Bear Creek Park-and-Ride instead of Avondale.
- Would operate later than existing Route 248.

Changes are shown in bold red type.
