Snow/Emergency Service Servicio de emergencia

During most snow conditions, routes 5 and 355 will operate via the snow routing shown in this timetable. In the rare event that Metro declares an emergency, Route 5 will continue to operate as a designated Emergency Snow Network route, but Route 355 will cease to operate.

What To Pay

Effective July 1, 2018, Metro will convert to a single Adult fare of \$2.75, anytime, anywhere. 1-Zone/2-Zone fares and peak/off-peak fares will no longer apply. ORCA LIFT, Youth, RRFAP and child fares will not change.

Bike & Ride

Metro buses have bike racks that hold three bikes. The racks are easy to use at no extra cost. Just follow the simple instructions posted near the rack.

How to Pay

At all times, pay your fare when you board the bus. Pay with cash (exact fare; drivers do not carry change), ticket or with a convenient regional ORCA card. Show your activated Transit GO Ticket (mobile ticket) or valid transfer to the driver.
