## Adverse Weather Information *Información meteorológica adversa*

During adverse weather conditions when Metro can not safely negotiate certain roadways, Route 887 morning service will be canceled. If normal morning service transported students to school and return service is needed in the afternoon, Route 887 will provide reverse service through the Lake Heights loop, with a deviation south to Newcastle Way (see map). In the rare event that Metro declares an emergency, this route will not operate. Sign up for Transit Alerts to stay informed during adverse conditions.

Durante las condiciones climáticas adversas cuando metro no puede negociar con seguridad ciertos caminos, el servicio matutino de Route 887 será cancelado. Si el servicio matutino normal transporta a los estudiantes a la escuela y el servicio de regreso es necesario por la tarde, la ruta 887 proporcionará servicio inverso a través del bucle Lake Heights, con una desviación sur a Newcastle Way (Ver mapa). En el raro caso de que metro declare una emergencia, esta ruta no funcionará. ## ORCA Card

Metro Transit and eight other Puget Sound transportation agencies (Community Transit, Everett Transit, Kitsap Transit, Pierce Transit, Sound Transit, Seattle Streetcar, King County Water Taxi and Washington State Ferries) use a common fare-payment system called ORCA (One Regional Card for All). The ORCA card works as cash or a pass, and it automatically tracks the value of your fares and transfers, letting you move easily between the participating transportation systems.

The ORCA Web site also provides information on how to use the card, as well as locations at which they can be reloaded with a new pass or additional cash.
