How to Pay

At all times, pay your fare **when you board** the bus. Pay with cash (exact fare; drivers do not carry change), ticket or with a convenient regional ORCA card. Show your activated Transit GO Ticket (mobile ticket) or valid transfer to the driver. Metro transfers are valid on Metro, only. See "How to pay" on Metro's website for more information.

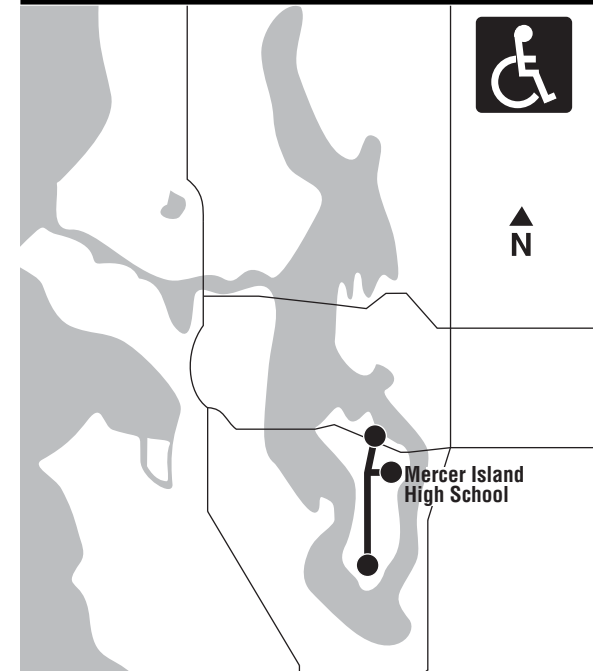

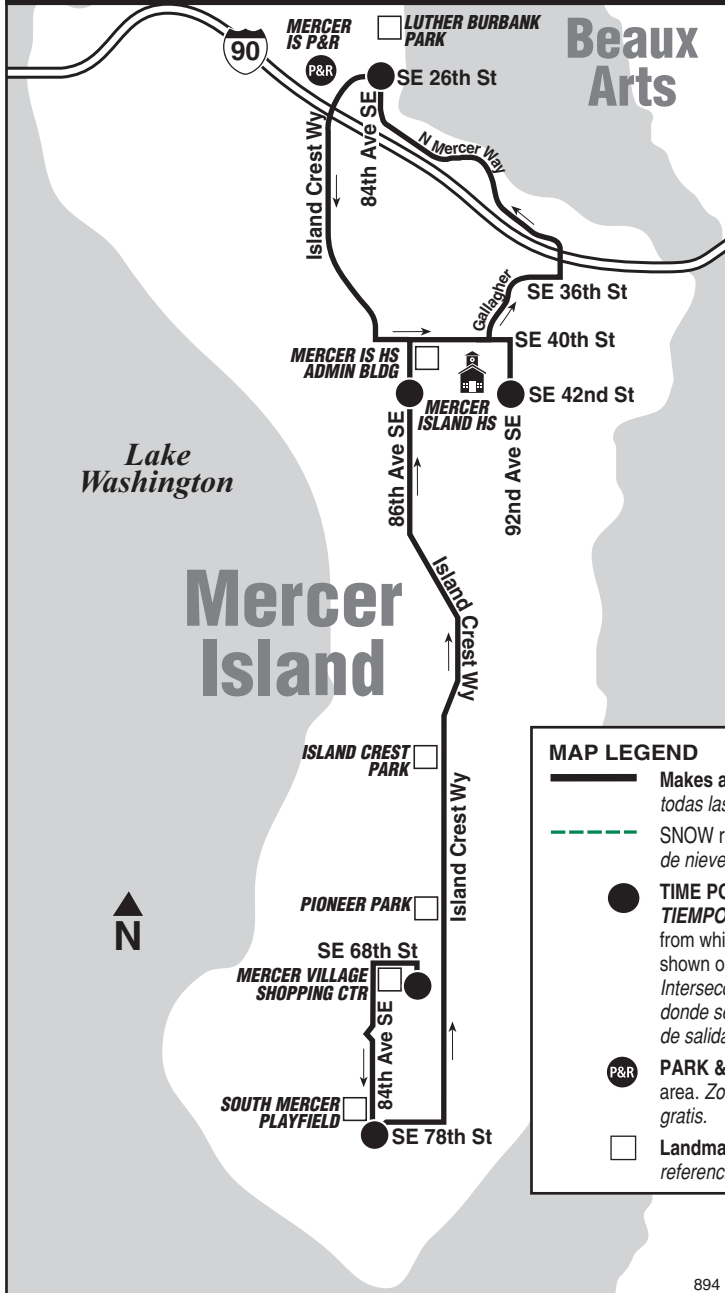

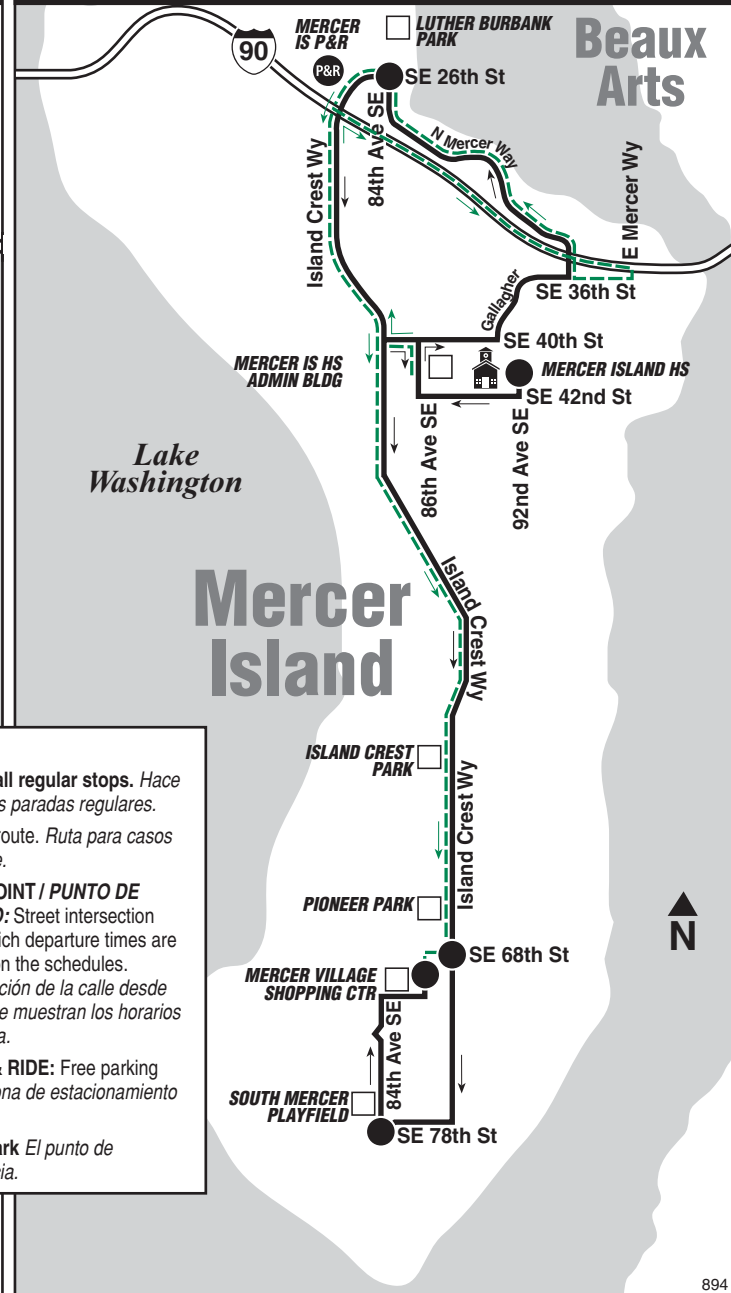

Adverse Weather Information

Información meteorológica adversa
 During adverse weather conditions when Metro can not safely negotiate certain roadways, Route 894 morning service will be canceled. If normal morning service transported students to school and return service is needed in the afternoon, Route 894 will not serve the normal school stop on 92nd Ave SE, but will stop instead at the Administration Building on 86th Ave SE. Service will also not be provided in the south island loop via SE 78th St and 84th Ave SE. See map. In the rare event that Metro declares an emergency, this route will not operate. For additional adverse weather information, call Metro at 206-553-3000, or visit Metro at kingcounty.gov/metro. Sign up for Transit Alerts to stay informed during adverse conditions.

Durante las condiciones climáticas adversas cuando el metro no puede negociar con seguridad ciertos caminos, el servicio matutino de Route 894 será cancelado. Si el servicio matutino normal transporta a los estudiantes a la escuela y el servicio de regreso es necesario por la tarde, la ruta 894 no servirá a la parada normal de la escuela en 92 ave se, sino que se detendrá en su lugar en el edificio de administración en el 86 ave se. el servicio tampoco se proporcionará en el bucle South Island Via se 78 St y 84 ave se.
