ORCA Card

Metro Transit and eight other Puget Sound transportation agencies (Community Transit, Everett Transit, Kitsap Transit, Pierce Transit, Sound Transit, Seattle Streetcar, King County Water Taxi and Washington State Ferries) use a common fare-payment system called ORCA (One Regional Card for All).

VanShare

Let VanShare bridge the gap in your commute. Starting a vanshare is simple. You just need five people including a volunteer driver. Use it to make the connection to your final destination from any transportation terminal.

How to Pay

At all times, pay your fare when you board the bus. Pay with cash (exact fare; drivers do not carry change), ticket or with a convenient regional ORCA card.

Night Stop Program

For your added safety at night, you may request to exit the bus at a location along your route other than a regular bus stop. To do so, please go to the front of the bus and ask your driver at least one block before your desired stop.

Night Rider Tip

You can help drivers spot you when it is dark or during times of reduced visibility by wearing light-colored clothing and by standing in the most visible area of the bus stop.

Text for Bus Times

If you want bus arrival times at your stop, both scheduled times and real times, try Metro's new texting tool for getting up to the next three trips of any route that serves your bus stop.
