Route 982 Fare Information

Use your ORCA card to ride Metro, Sound Transit, Community Transit and Pierce Transit buses. Purchase ORCA cards and ticketbooks (tickets valid on Metro, only) from your school's business office.

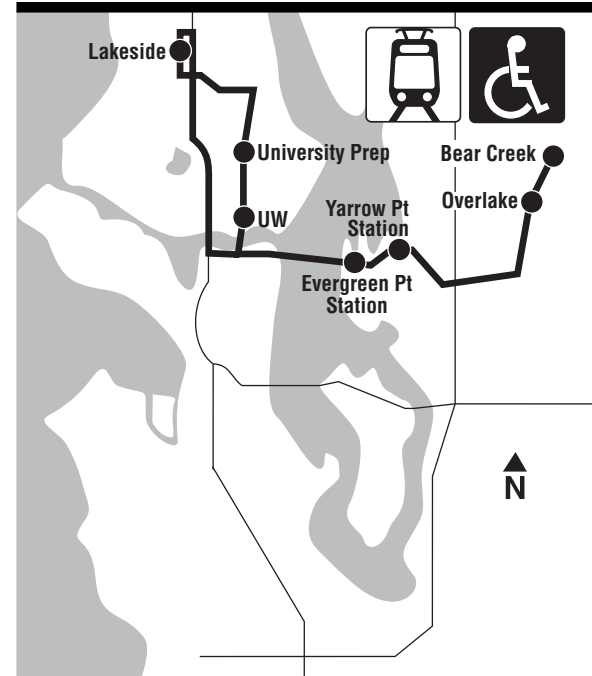

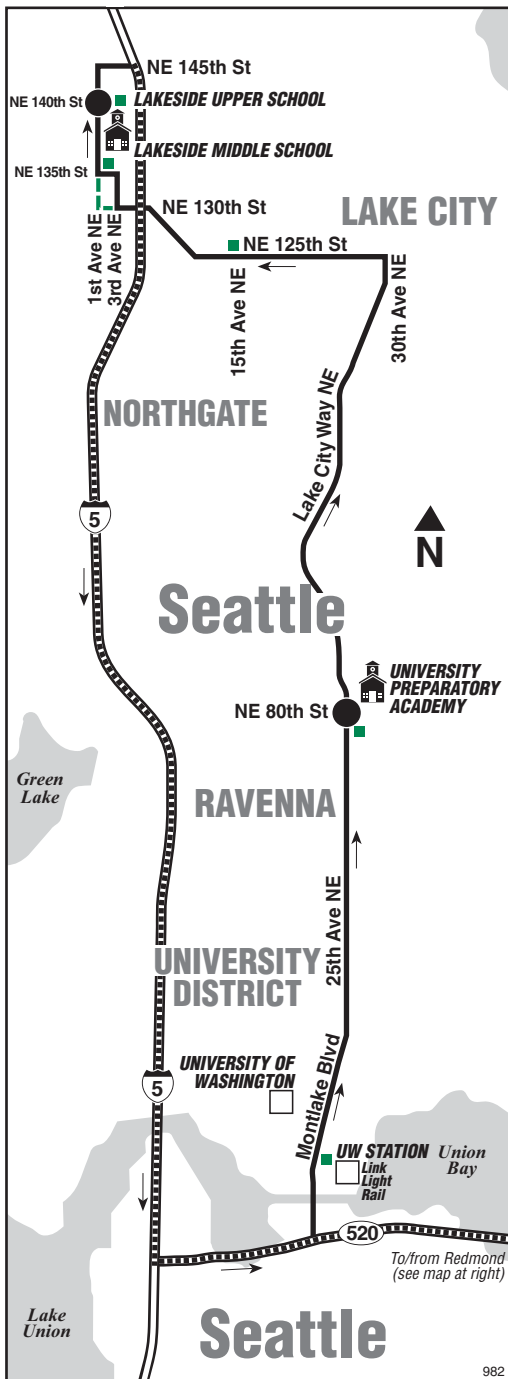

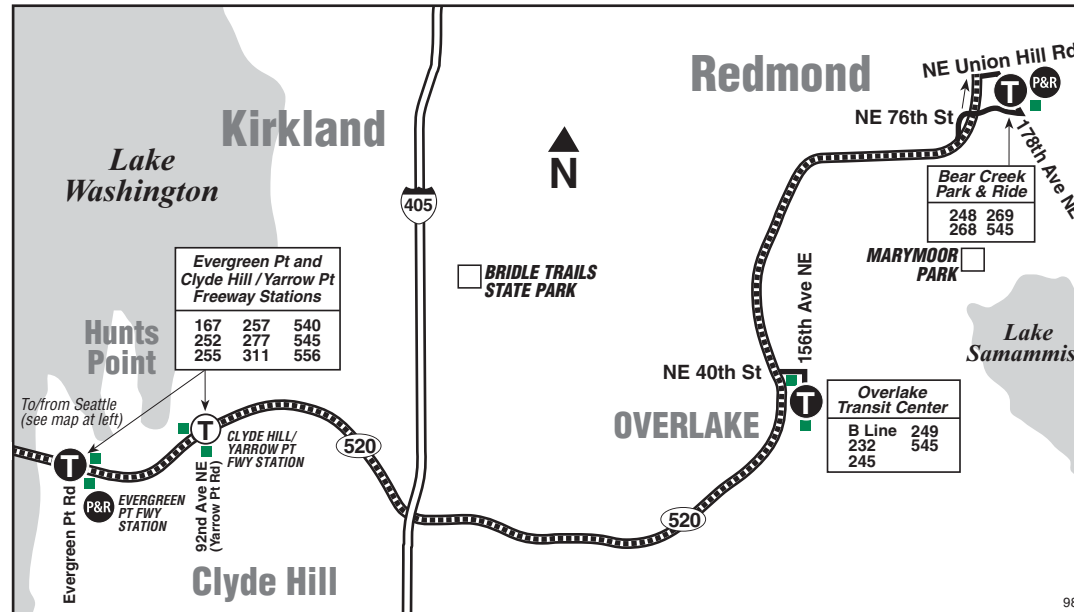
