

## Online Trip Planning

Use Metro's online Trip Planner to plan trips on scheduled service in King, Pierce and Snohomish counties. It provides details on transit stops, routes and schedules. Trip Planner itineraries do not include service disruptions and reroutes caused by weather, emergencies, traffic, events or construction.

Trip Planner includes Metro Transit, Pierce Transit, Community Transit, Everett Transit, ST Express buses, Link light rail, Sounder commuter rail, King County Water Taxi, Washington State Ferries, the Seattle Center Monorail, and Seattle Streetcar.

## ORCA Card

Metro Transit and eight other Puget Sound transportation agencies (Community Transit, Everett Transit, Kitsap Transit, Pierce Transit, Sound Transit, Seattle Streetcar, King County Water Taxi and Washington State Ferries) use a common fare-payment system called ORCA (One Regional Card for All). The ORCA card works as cash or a pass, and it automatically tracks the value of your fares and transfers, letting you move easily between the participating transportation systems.

The ORCA website also provides information on how to use the card, as well as locations at which they can be reloaded with a new pass or additional cash.

## Link Light Rail

Transfers to/from Link can be made at the UW Link Station at NE Pacific St & Montlake Blvd NE.

During both morning and afternoon weekday rush hour periods, Link operates about every 6 minutes, and about every 10-15 minutes during midday and evening periods. On Saturday and Sunday, Link operates about every 10-15 minutes. Please refer to Sound Transit's Transit Guide for complete schedule information.

## How to Pay

At all times, pay your fare **when you board** the bus. Pay with cash (exact fare; drivers do not carry change), ticket or with a convenient regional ORCA card. Show your activated Transit GO Ticket (mobile ticket) or valid transfer to the driver. Metro transfers are valid on Metro, only. See "How to pay" on Metro's website for more information.

# Text for Bus Times

If you want bus arrival times at your stop, both scheduled times and real times, try Metro's new texting tool for getting up to the next three trips of any route that serves your bus stop. Simply text your bus stop number to 62550 and follow the prompts. Metro buses have bike racks that hold three bikes. The racks are easy to use at no extra cost. Just follow the simple instructions posted near the rack. You may load or unload your bike anytime at all regular Metro bus stops, including downtown Seattle and the transit tunnel.
