## Adverse Weather Information *Información meteorológica adversa*

During adverse weather conditions when Metro can not safely negotiate certain roadways, Route 824 morning service will be canceled. If normal morning service transported students to school and return service is needed in the afternoon, Route 824 will continue southbound on Coal Creek Pkwy SE and terminate at Coal Creek Pkwy SE & Newport Wy SE. Service will not be provided on Forest Dr SE to SE 63rd St & 156th Ave SE. In the rare event that Metro declares an emergency, this route will not operate. Sign up for Transit Alerts to stay informed during adverse conditions.

Upon boarding, pay your fare with exact change or a convenient regional ORCA card. ORCA cards are sold in downtown Seattle at Metro customer service offices in King Street Center and the Westlake tunnel station.

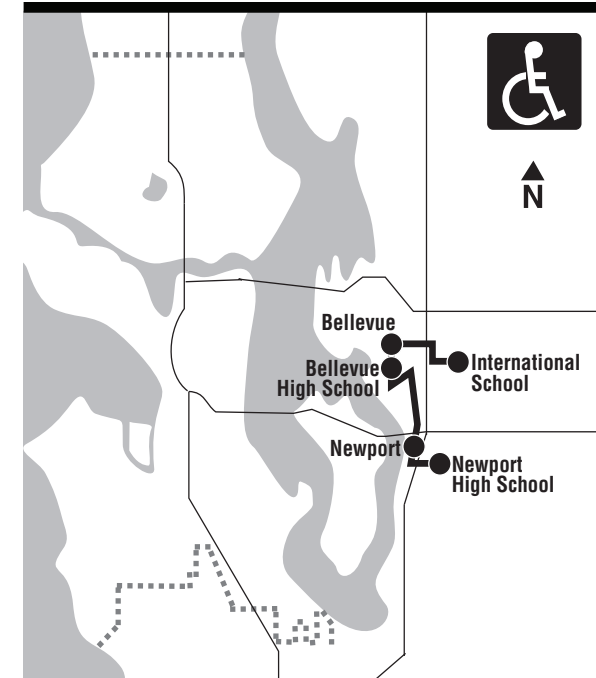

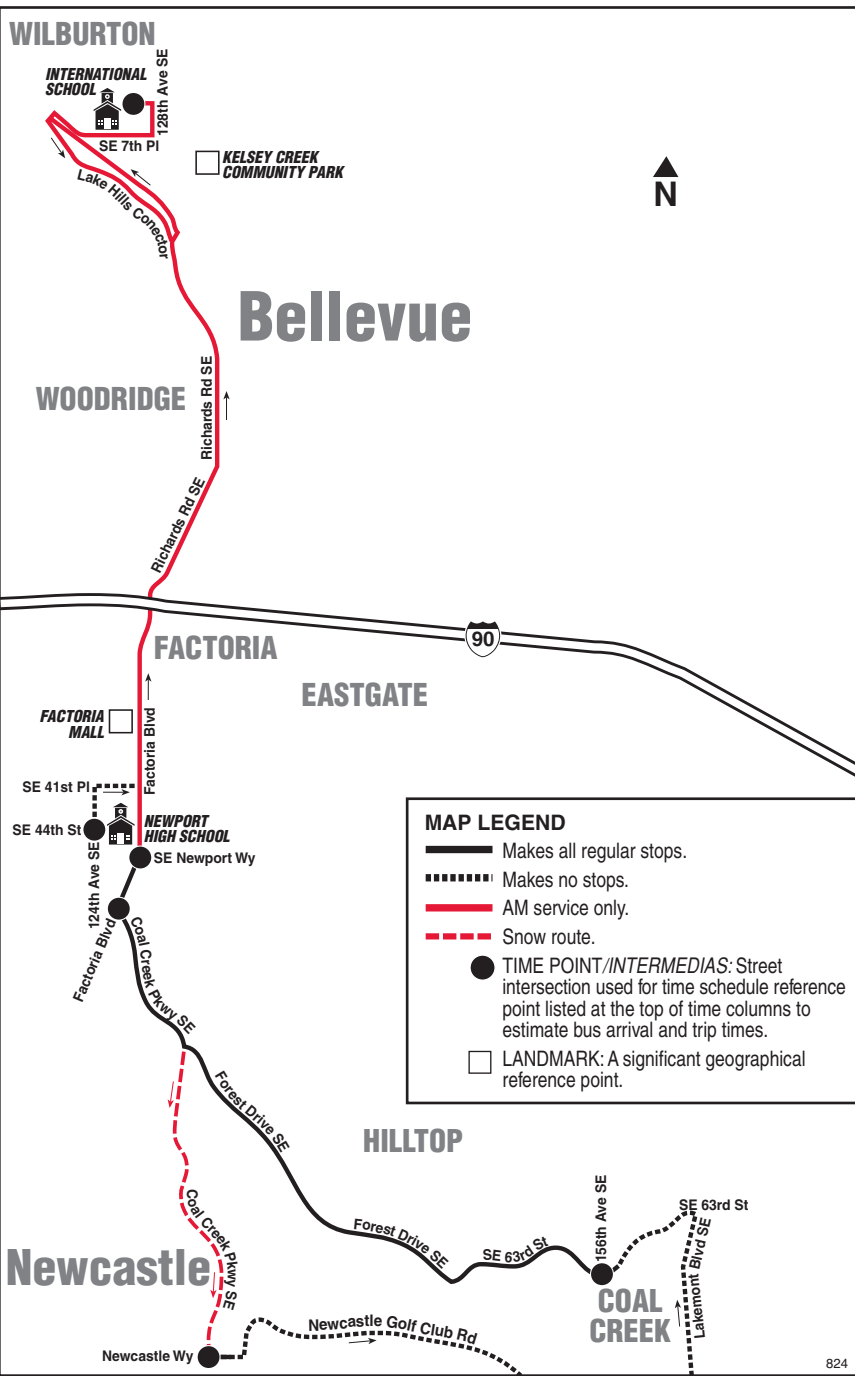

## ORCA Card

Metro Transit and eight other Puget Sound transportation agencies (Community Transit, Everett Transit, Kitsap Transit, Pierce Transit, Sound Transit, Seattle Streetcar, King County Water Taxi and Washington State Ferries) use a common fare-payment system called ORCA (One Regional Card for All). The ORCA card works as cash or a pass, and it automatically tracks the value of your fares and transfers, letting you move easily between the participating transportation systems.

The ORCA Web site also provides information on how to use the card, as well as locations at which they can be reloaded with a new pass or additional cash.

## Text for Bus Times

If you want bus arrival times at your stop, both scheduled times and real times, try Metro's new texting tool for getting up to the next three trips of any route that serves your bus stop. Simply text your bus stop number to 62550 and follow the prompts. Bus stop numbers can be found at all Metro bus stops, via Metro's Trip Planner, the Puget Sound Trip Planner app, on Metro timetables (at timepoints, only; space available), and on Metro's website, [kingcounty.gov/metro](http://kingcounty.gov/metro).
