Show your activated Transit GO Ticket (mobile ticket) or valid transfer to the driver. Metro transfers are valid on Metro, only. 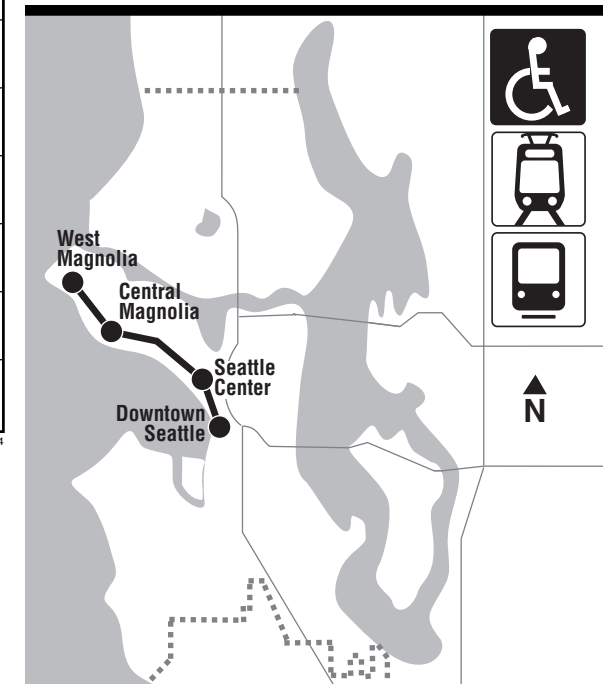

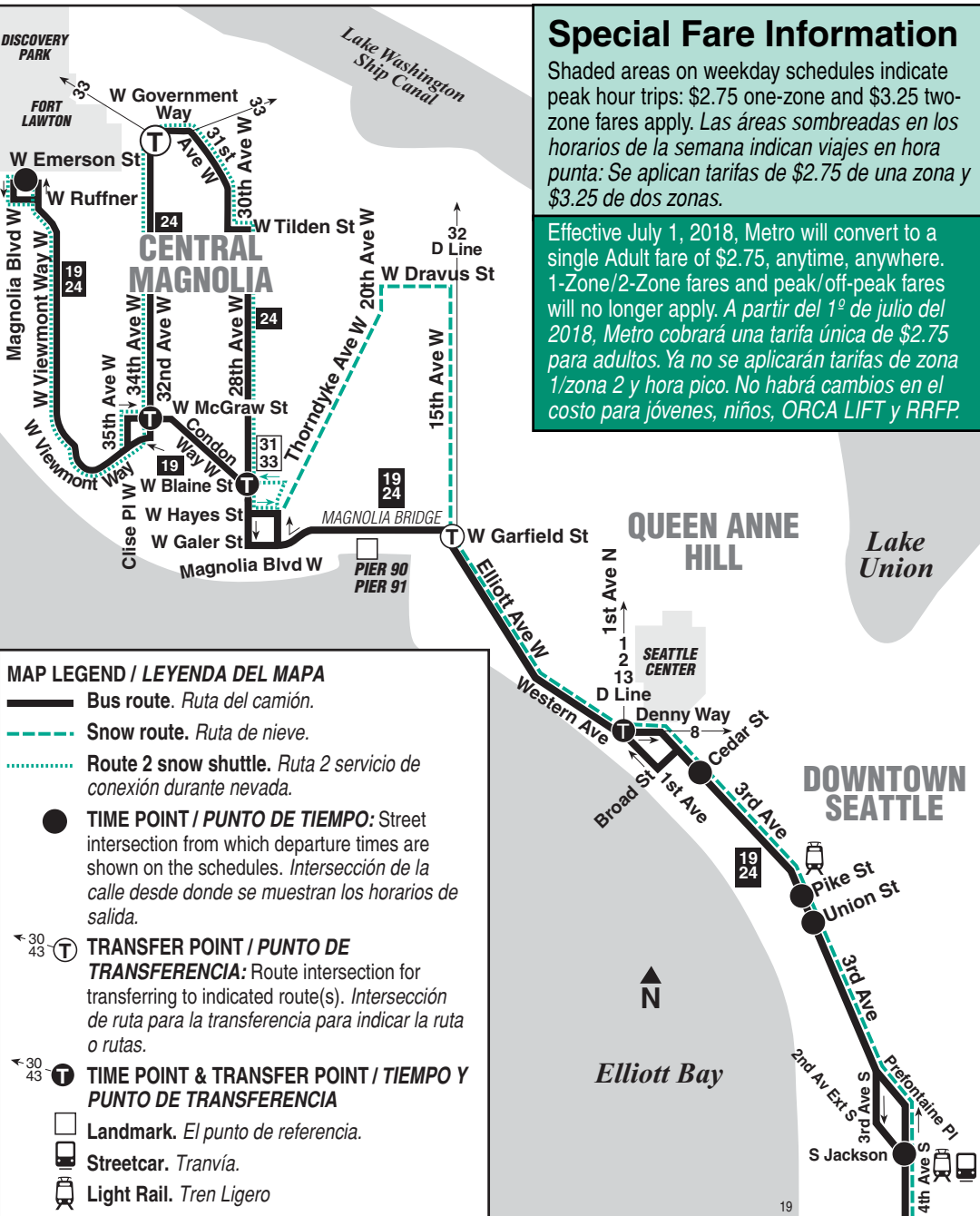

During most snow conditions, Route 19 will not operate, and Route 24 will operate via the snow routing shown in this timetable. In the rare event that Metro declares an emergency, Route 24 will continue to operate as a designated Emergency Service Network route, but Route 19 will cease to operate. During such an event, Route 24 is expected to operate with the same route number and follow the same snow routing as shown in this timetable. ORCA Card

Metro Transit and eight other Puget Sound transportation agencies (Community Transit, Everett Transit, Kitsap Transit, Pierce Transit, Sound Transit, Seattle Streetcar, King County Water Taxi and Washington State Ferries) use a common fare-payment system called ORCA (One Regional Card for All). The ORCA card works as cash or a pass, and it automatically tracks the value of your fares and transfers, letting you move easily between the participating transportation systems.
