

ORCA Card

Metro Transit and eight other Puget Sound transportation agencies (Community Transit, Everett Transit, Kitsap Transit, Pierce Transit, Sound Transit, Seattle Streetcar, King County Water Taxi and Washington State Ferries) use a common fare-payment system called ORCA (One Regional Card for All). The ORCA card works as cash or a pass, and it automatically tracks the value of your fares and transfers, letting you move easily between the participating transportation systems.

Get your ORCA card online at www.orcacard.com, by phone at 1-888-988-6722 (ORCA) or TTY Relay: 711 (1-888-889-6368), at ticket vending machines in Sounder and Link rail stations, or at one of the transit agency customer service offices. The ORCA Web site also provides information on how to use the card, as well as locations at which they can be reloaded with a new pass or additional cash.

Purchase ORCA cards and ticketbooks (tickets valid on Metro, only) from your school's business office. **The cash fare for this route is \$5.25 one-way or \$189 per month.** For fares on Metro's regular service, see "What To Pay".

Pay As You Board

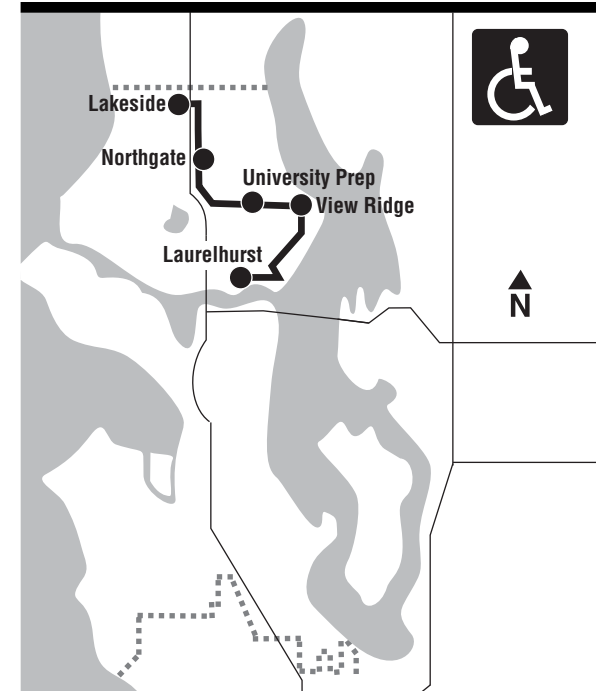

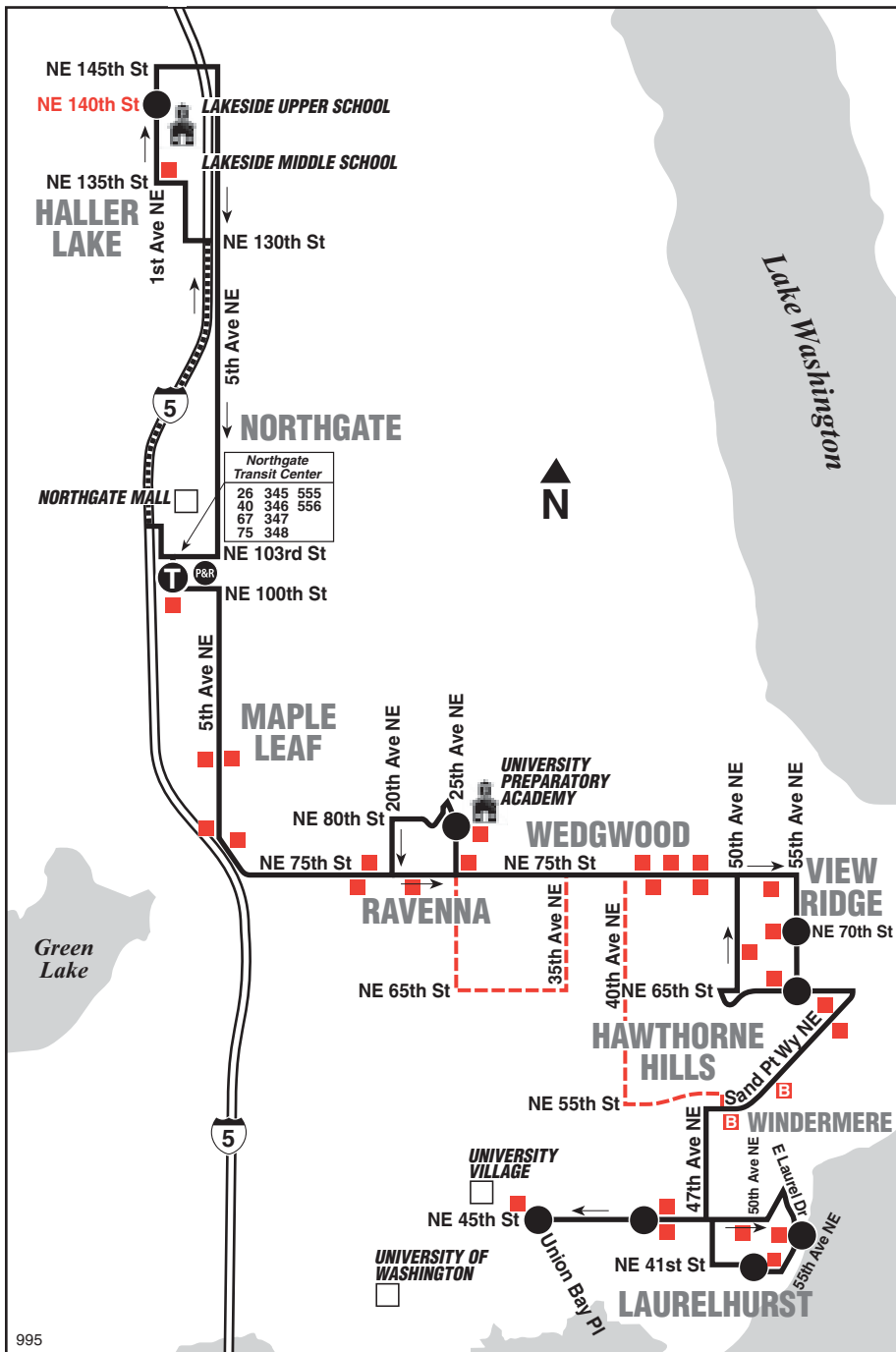

Adverse Weather Information

During adverse weather conditions when Metro cannot safely negotiate certain roadways, Route 995 will be rerouted from Sand Point Way NE, View Ridge and portions of NE 75th St to the alternative streets shown on the map. Metro buses have bike racks that hold three bikes. The racks are easy to use at no extra cost. Just follow the simple instructions posted near the rack. You may load or unload your bike anytime at all regular Metro bus stops, including downtown Seattle and the transit tunnel.
