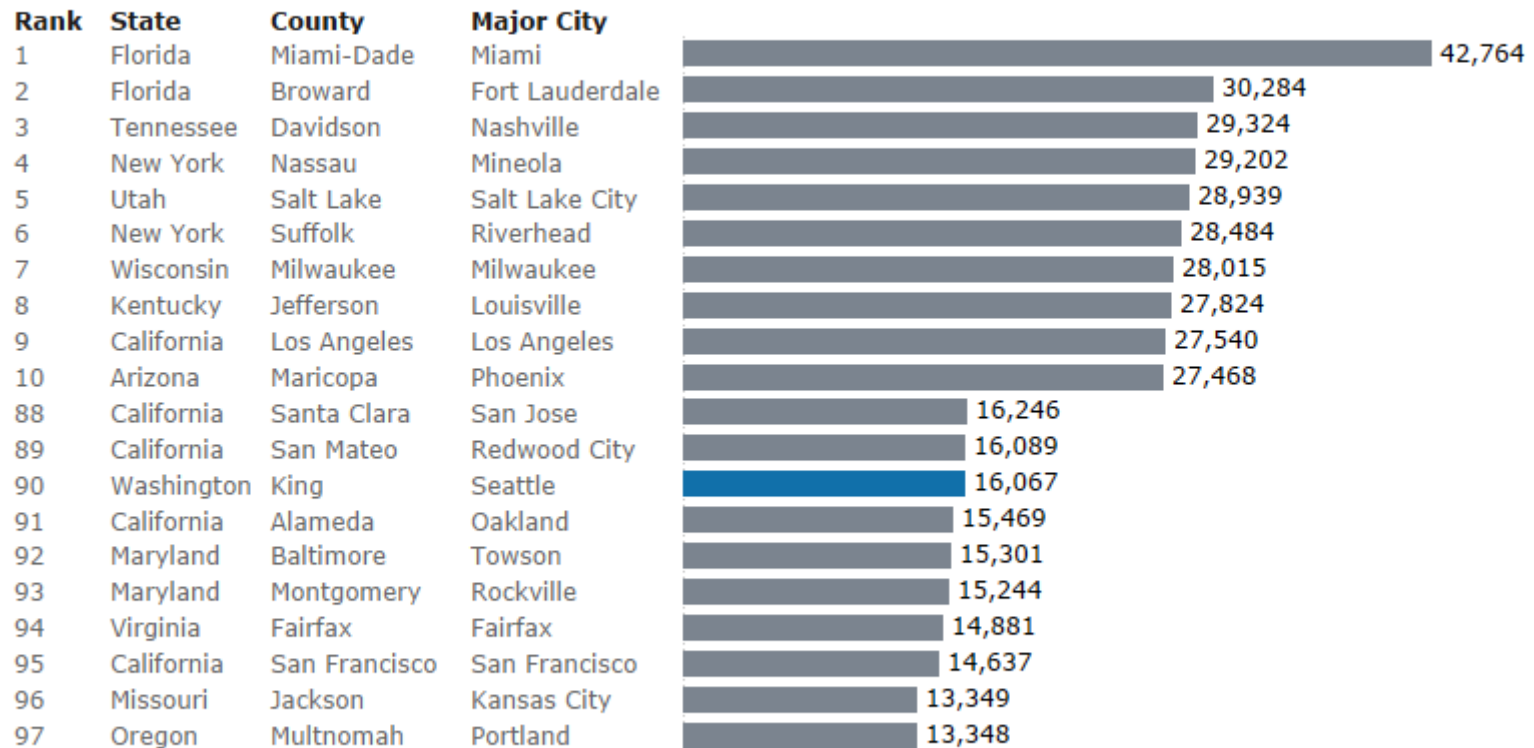


How has King County compared nationally?

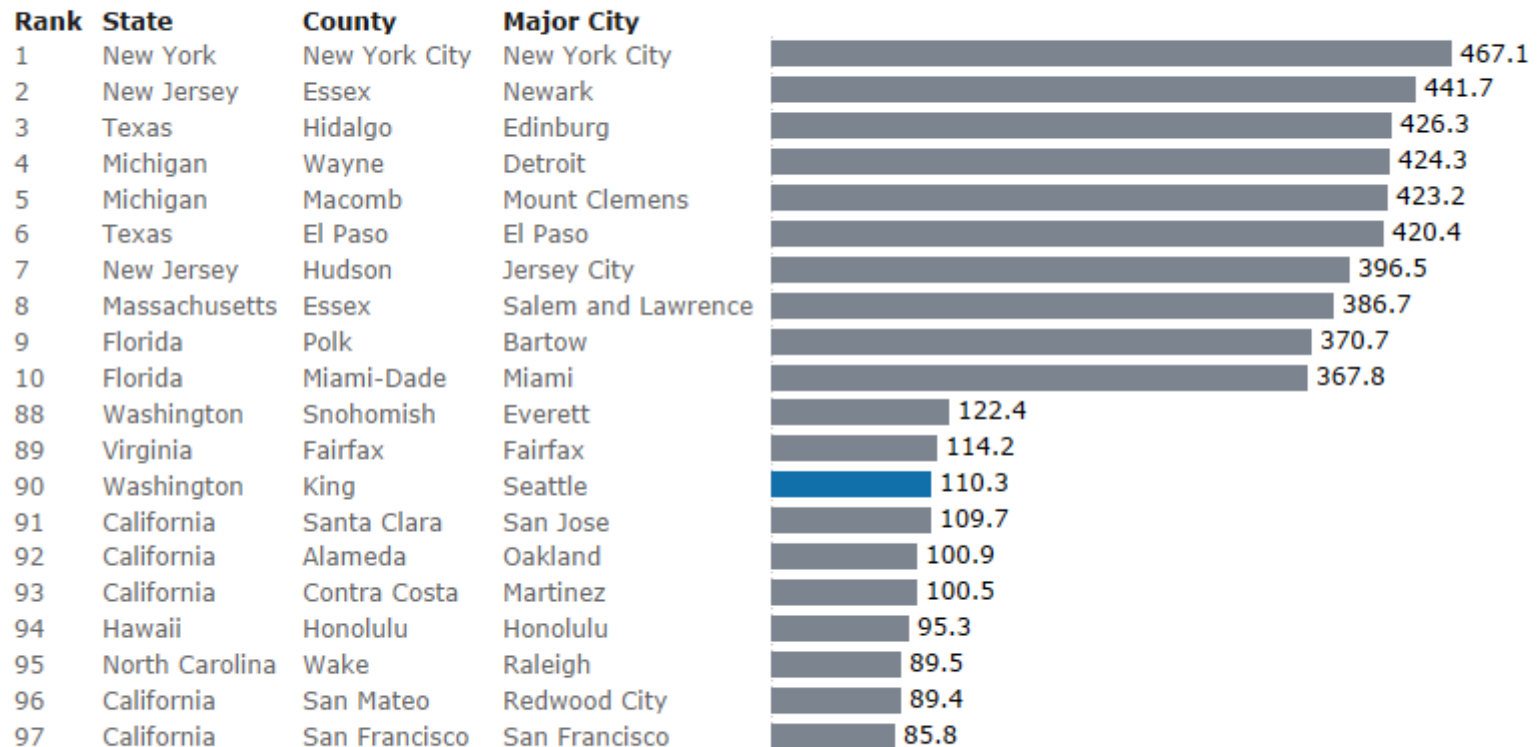

- Among the 100 most populous counties,
 - KC ranks 12th highest among total population vaccinated
 - KC ranks 11th highest among adult population vaccinated
 - KC ranks 8th highest among adult population boosted
