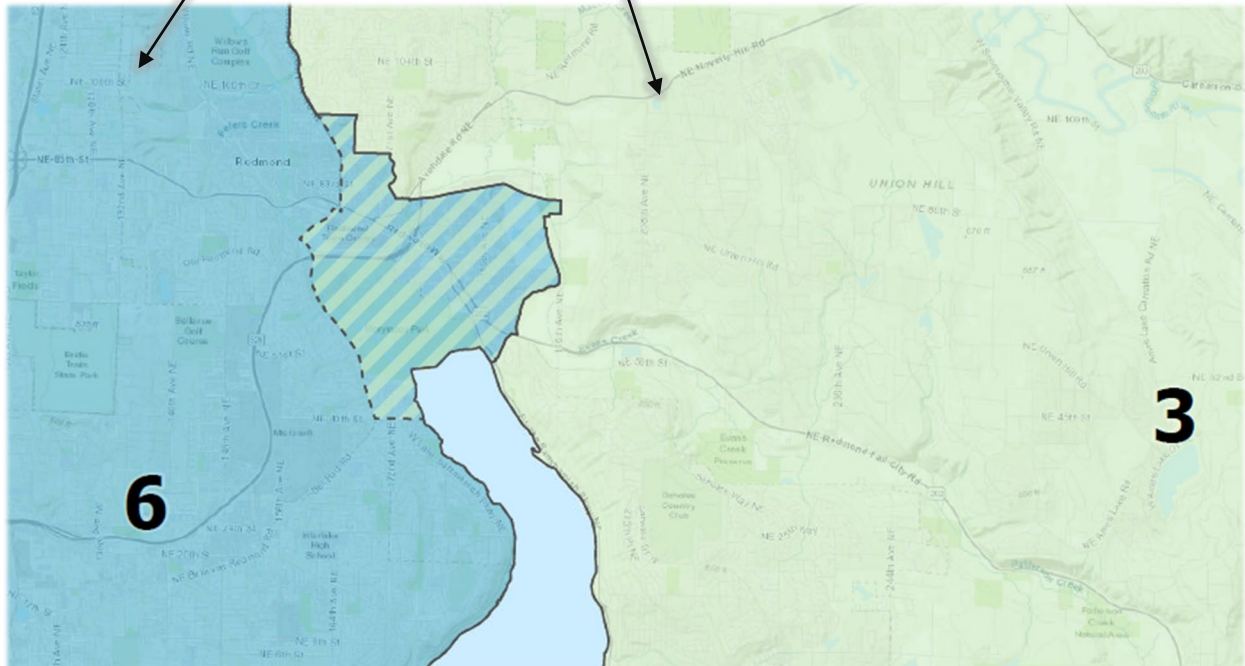
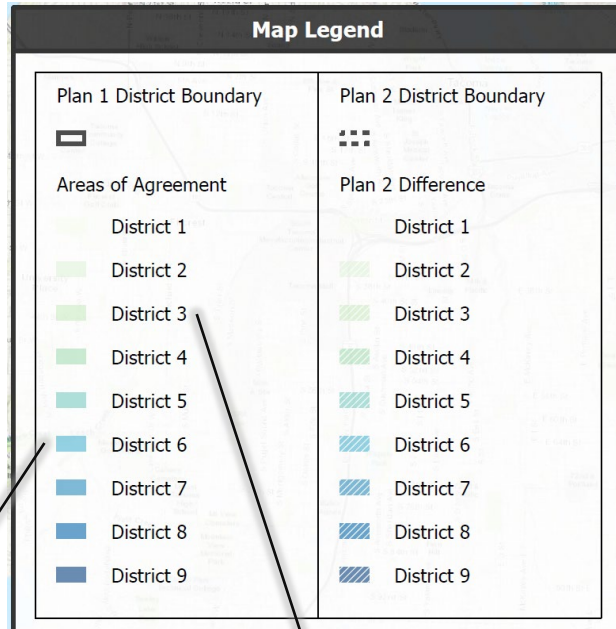


How to Interpret Areas of Agreement & Difference Maps

These maps compare the 4 submitted draft plans from the Districting Committee against one another. The maps show where the plans agree and where they differ.

Where the Plans Agree:

- The areas without hatching (solid colors) represent areas where the two plans agree.



Where the Plans Disagree:

- The areas with hatching represent where the plans disagree. The 2 different hatching colors represent the district that each plan has designated in that area.
- In this example, the Plan 2 District Boundary (dotted line) pushes District 3 farther west from the Plan 1 District Boundary (solid line).
- The hatching shows the District 3 color (green) and the District 6 color (blue) and where the boundaries differ.
