This guide will help to get you started using Zoom and to successfully connect to a proceeding by video. Zoom is a real-time, web-based conferencing application. Zoom can be downloaded and installed on Windows, Mac, iOS, and Android devices.

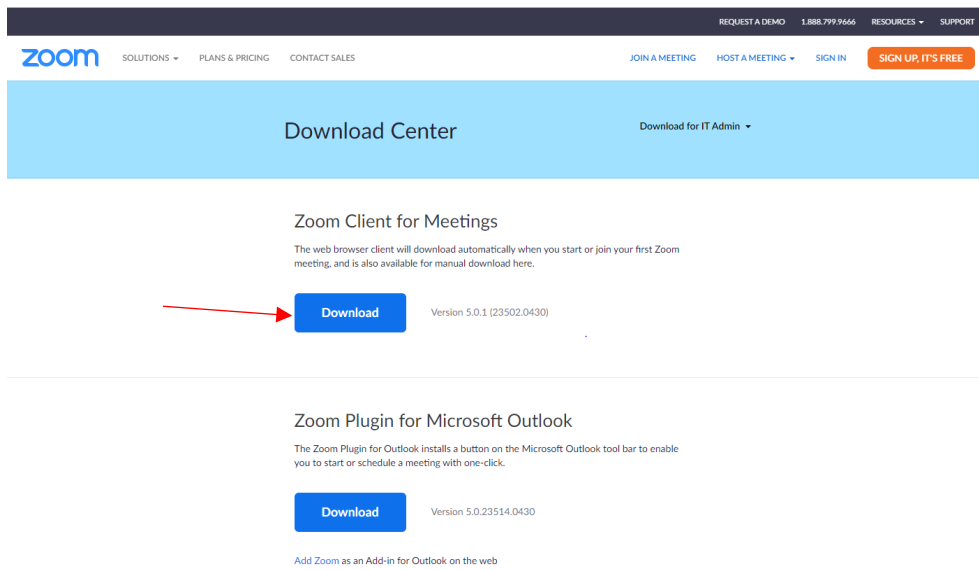

Appendix A: User Requirements

To participate in a proceeding via Zoom Video Conference, you must have access to a web camera and reliable, high speed internet connection.

Appendix B: Getting Started

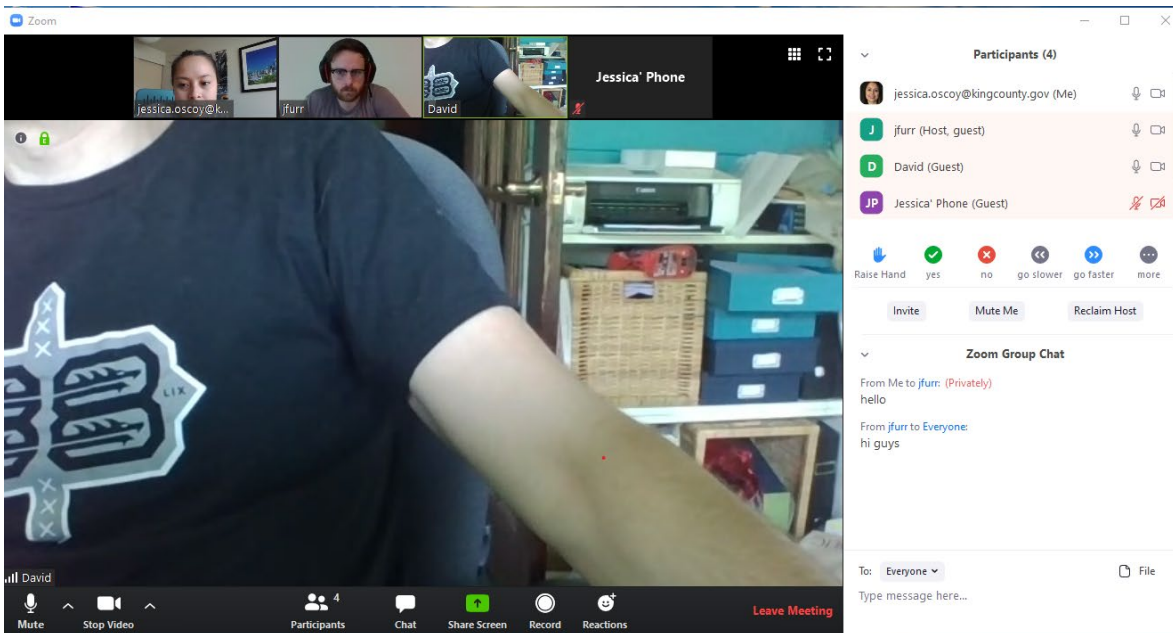
You do not need a paid account to use Zoom. Windows or MAC Install and Download - <https://zoom.us/download>. Install the Zoom Client for Meetings Web App.



Appendix C: Join by Video on your Computer

Only one microphone and speaker system should be active per physical location. Otherwise, multiple systems may cause noise and feedback.

1. To join *by video*, do the following:
 - a. Click the “Join Zoom Meeting” URL link provided in the emailed notice.
 - b. Then enter the meeting ID and password and your full name when prompted. Click to join the meeting. Please note: *You may need to type this in as copy and paste function may not work.*
 - c. A pop-up window will ask if would like to join using your computer audio or telephone. Select the appropriate connection.
 - d. You may be asked to wait in the lobby for the host.
 - e. Your screen will then look like this:



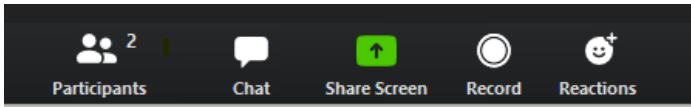
- f. Please familiarize yourself with the Mute, Video, Participants, and Chat icons on the bottom of your screen.
- g. The little up arrows on the Mute and Video icons allow you to test your video and microphone speakers.

Appendix D: Join by Telephone

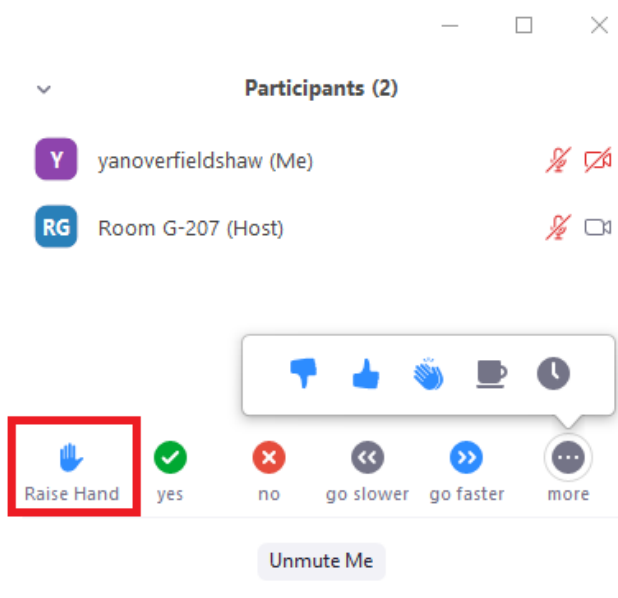
1. To join *by phone*, dial **+1 (253) 215-8782**. Once prompted, enter the meeting ID and any passcode followed by # (pound). Press # again to join as a participant. If you are not joining from the Seattle area, you can find your local number at: <https://us02web.zoom.us/j/ktEyioIr6>.
2. If it is time for you to speak, press *6 (star, six) to unmute. Press *6 to mute again. Please continue to remain muted if you are not speaking.

Appendix E: Raise hand /Participants View

1. To raise your hand in Zoom, click on the Participants icon on the bottom of your screen.



2. A sidebar will appear and the Raise Hand (blue hand icon) will show, along with other features.



3. To raise your hand if you are calling by telephone – audio only, press *9 (star, nine) on your keypad.

Appendix F: Chat

1. To send a message, click the Chat icon on the bottom of your screen. You can select the recipient of your message in the To: box
