



Complaints Reported by Community Members and Sheriff's Office Employees

Bottom line: There were 31 complaints reported in 2019 in District 5, and Internal Investigations Unit (IIU) classified 24 of those complaints as inquiries, or serious complaints. Those 24 complaints included 57 allegations of misconduct, with the top allegation category being appropriate use of authority. IIU sustained two of the 19 allegations misconduct related to of appropriate use of authority.


