

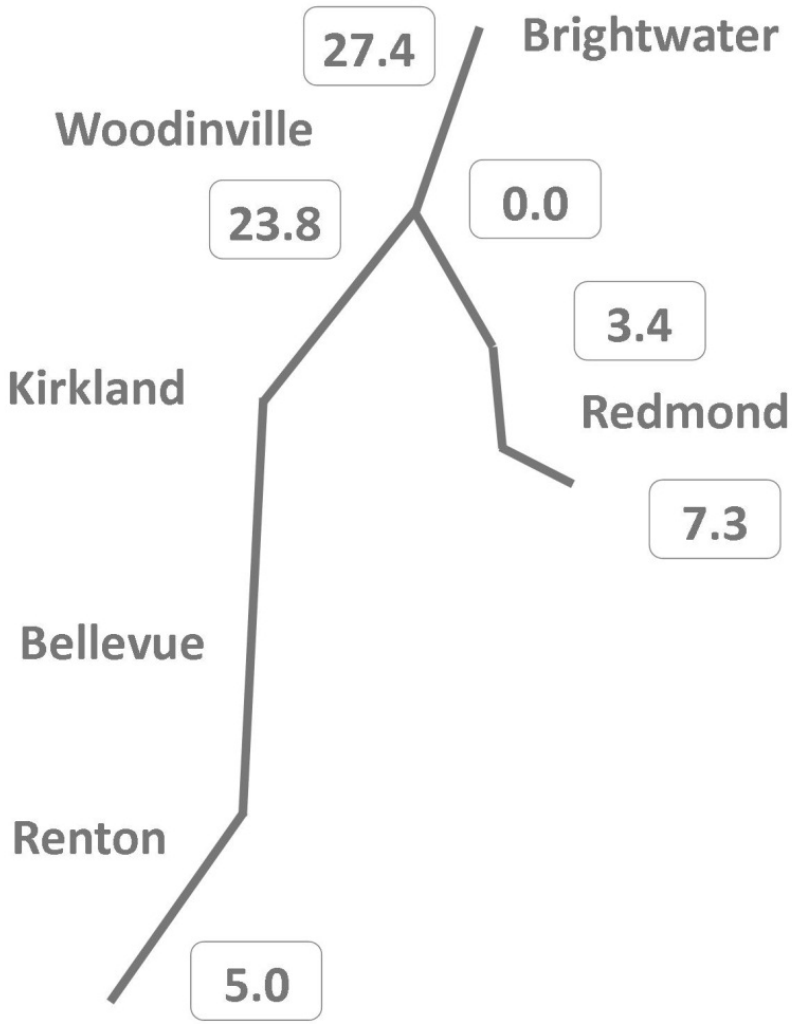

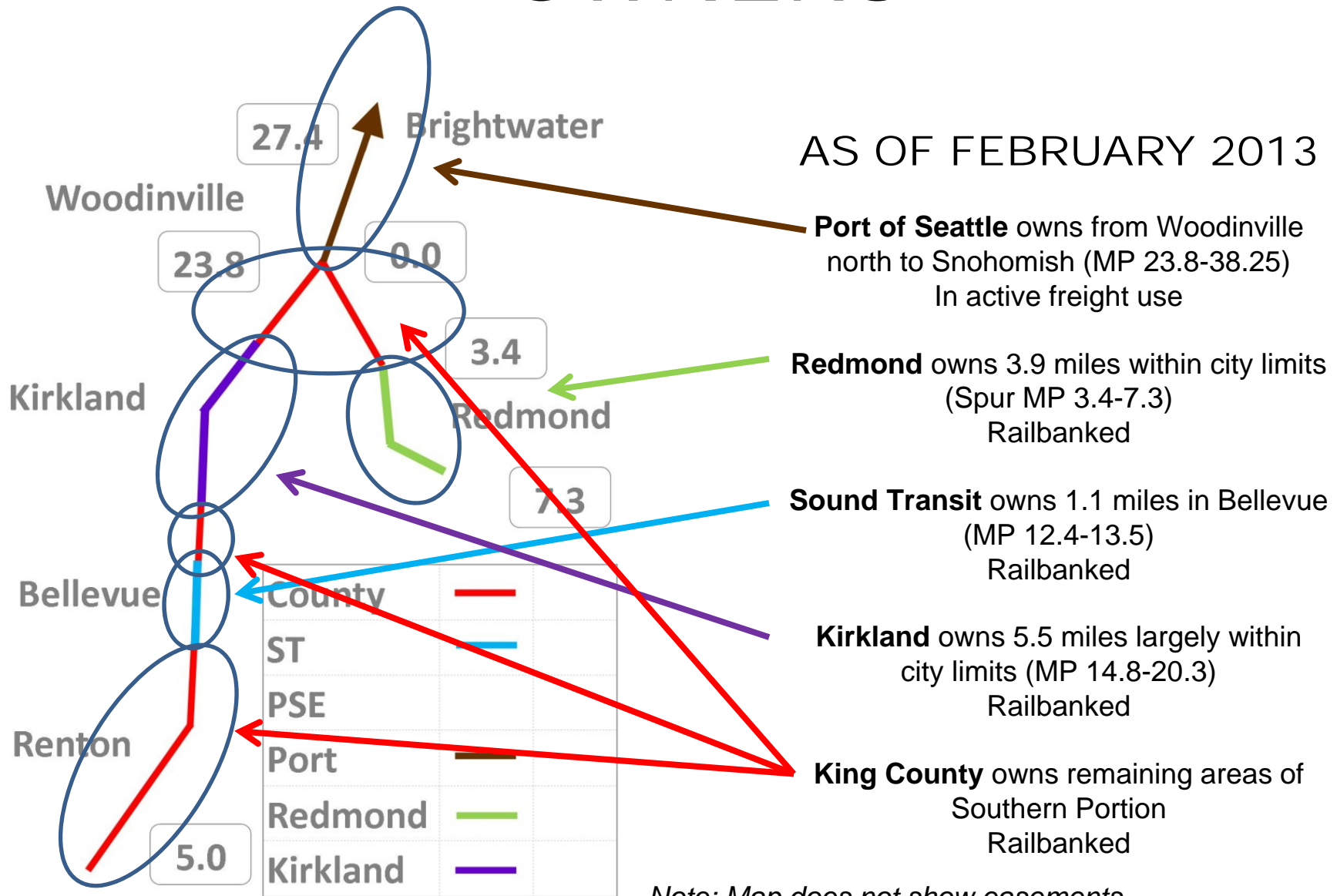


ERC IN KING COUNTY



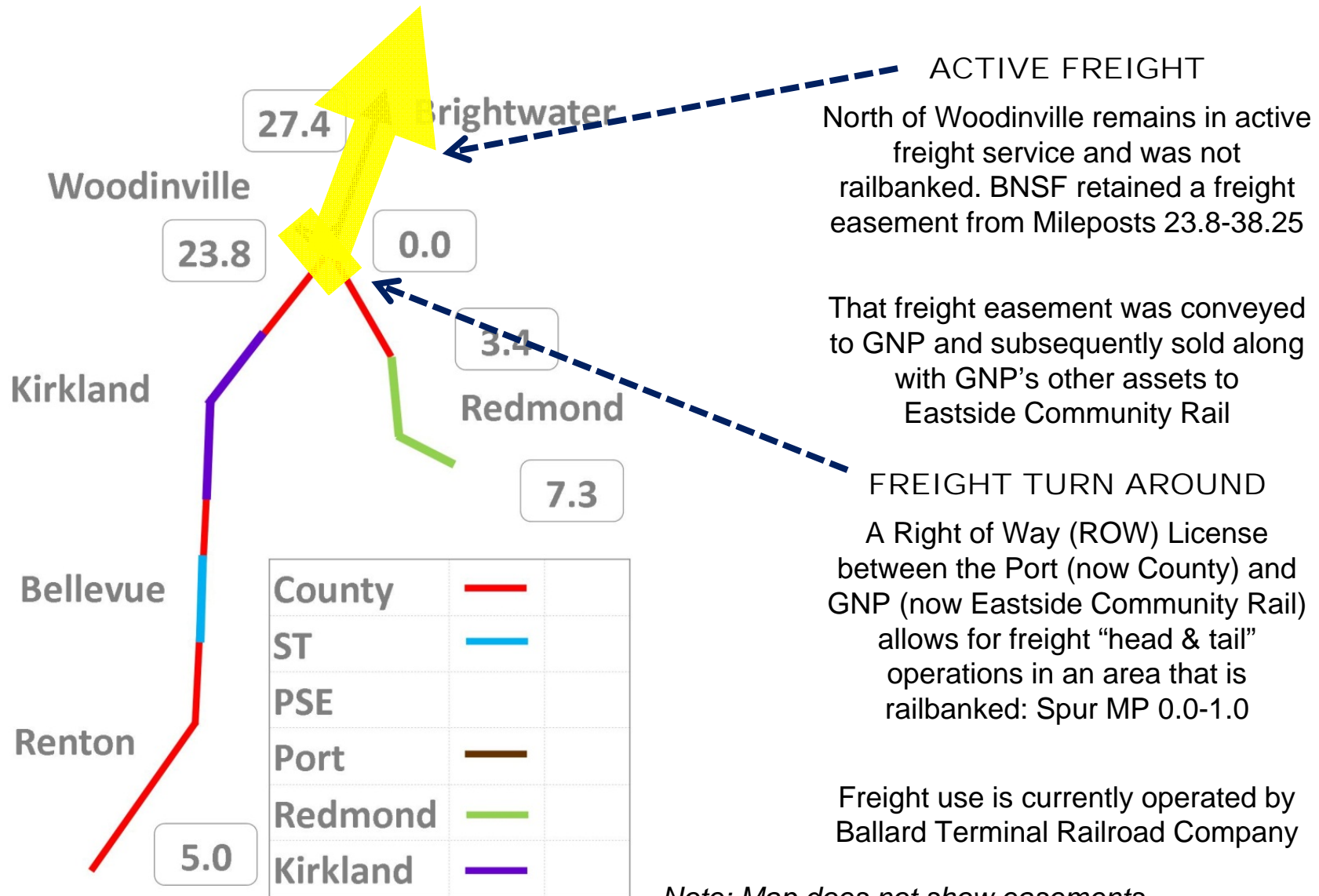

AS OF FEBRUARY 2013



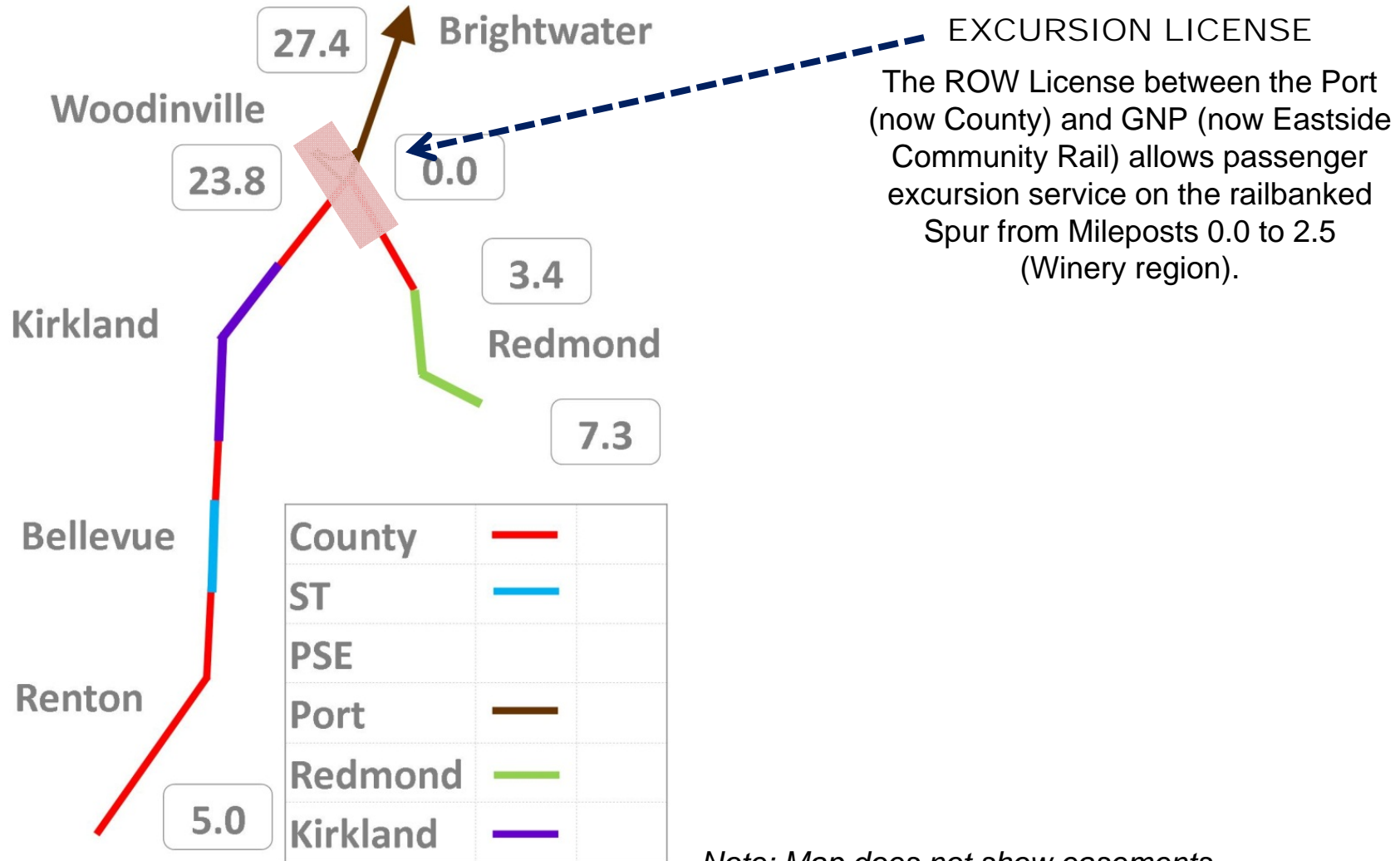

EXISTING FREIGHT USE



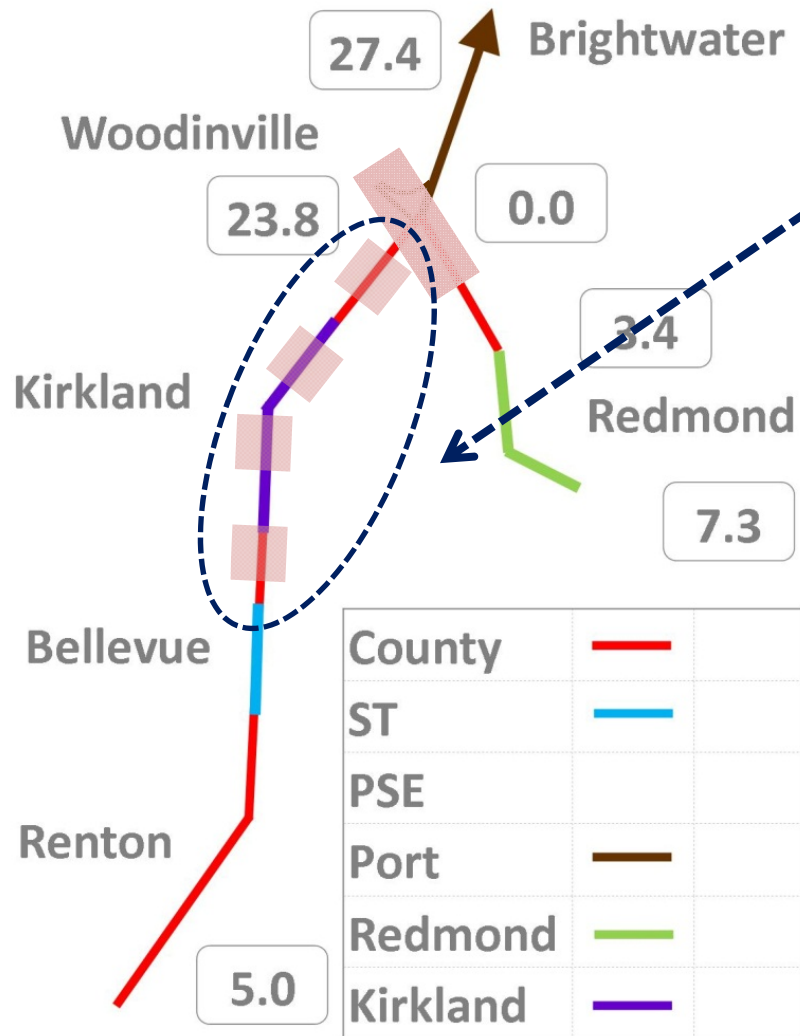

EXCURSION USE COMMENTS



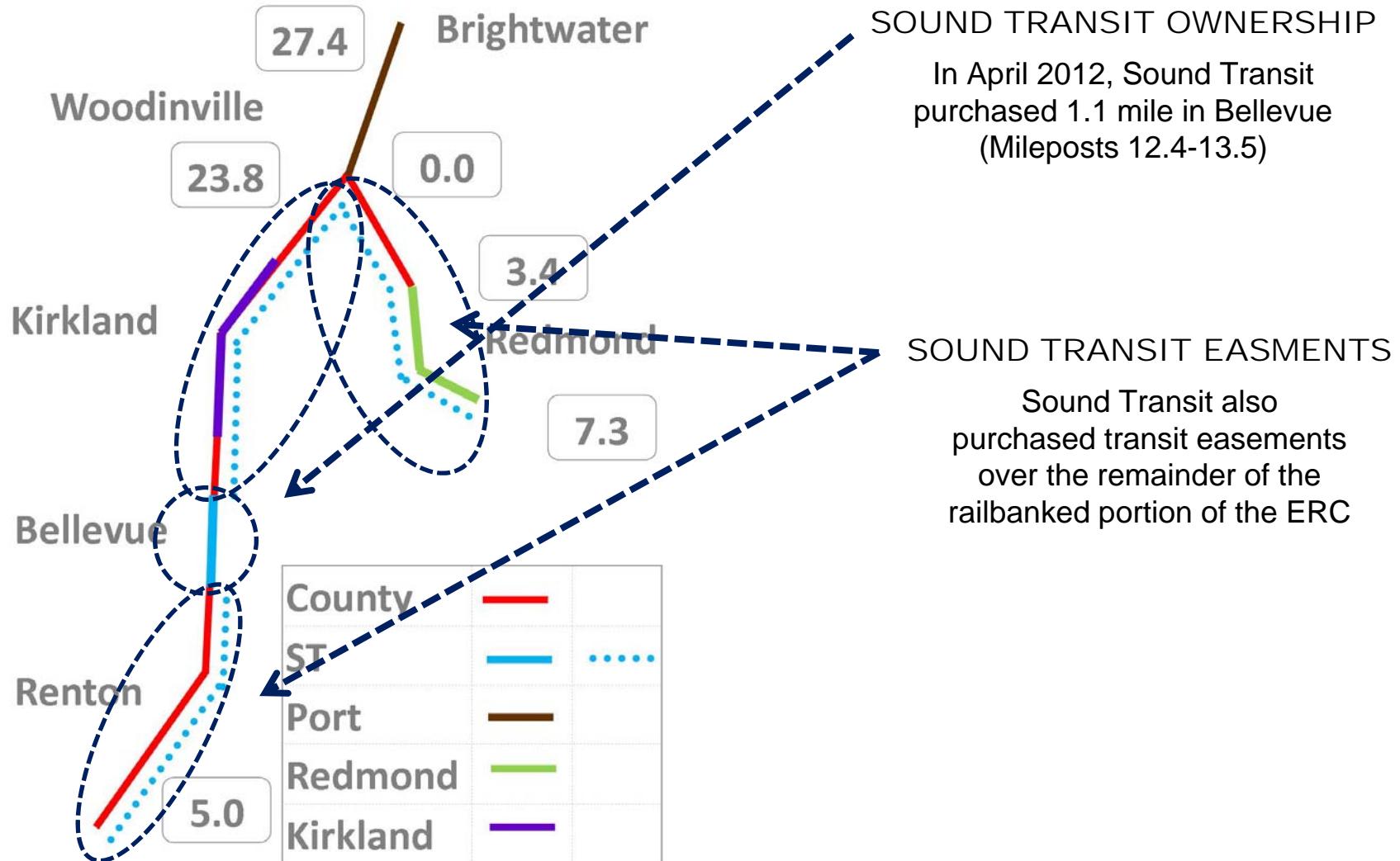
EXCURSION COMMENTS
 Eastside Community Rail owner, Douglas Engle, and staff person, Kathy Cox, have proposed extending excursion service to the south end of Kirkland.

No formal proposal has been made.

Excursion service would not require Surface Transportation Board approval. Rather, approval would be needed from the underlying owners of the Eastside Rail Corridor.

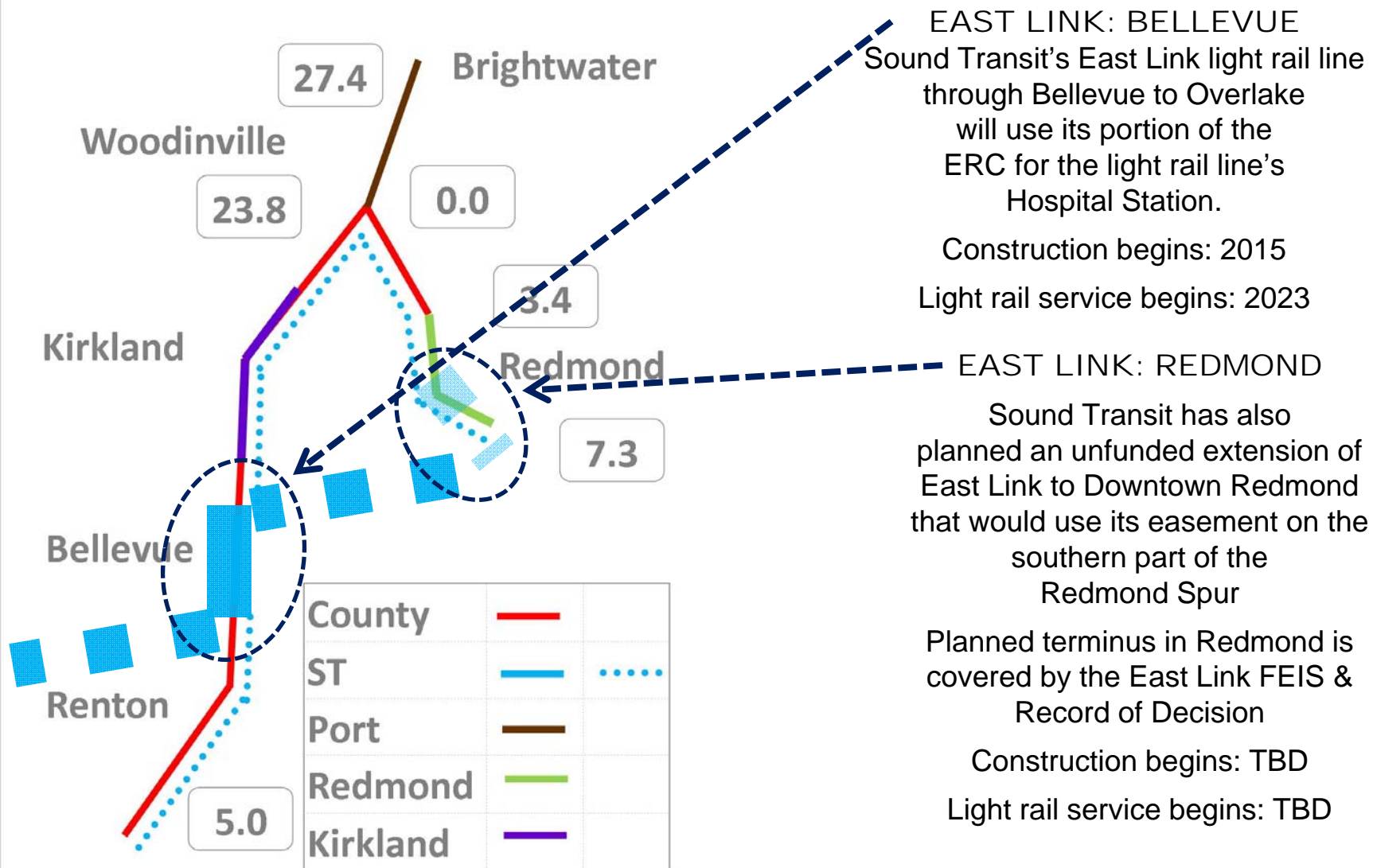
SOUND TRANSIT OWNERSHIP
